HOW TO CLEAN YOUR CUTLERY

Bambaw's cutlery is handcrafted from organic bamboo and treated with vegetal oil, so no chemicals are involved in the production process. However, make sure to wash the cutlery before the first use.

Cutlery

The utensils can be put in the dishwasher or simply washed by hand.

Handwashing the utensils is recommended to ensure the longevity of the cutlery. Simply clean them with warm soapy water. Make sure to dry them thoroughly after the wash. Please avoid leaving the utensils in water for too long.

Straw

As for the cutlery the straw can be washed in the dishwasher or by hand.

To clean the straw, use the cleaning brush. Rinse the straws with a warm soapy water and allow them to dry completely.

To ensure the longevity of the utensils and keep a low footprint, please avoid the use of strong chemicals when cleaning the set, favoring more ecofriendly alternatives. Tips on how to take care your set with eco-friendly products are provided below.





SPECIAL CARE

Deep Cleaning

After having used the utensils with staining or smelly food you might want to give it a deeper clean. Use white vinegar or lime juice to clean and disinfect the cutlery. Make a solution of water, vinegar or lime juice and baking soda, soak the utensils in the blend for 20 minutes to remove odors and stains. Rinse thoroughly with hot water and towel dry immediately.

Oil Conditioning

Every few months, oil your utensils to keep them at their best. Apply a food safe oil like walnut oil, coconut oil or almond oil to a rag. Do not use olive oil as it goes rancid too quickly. Rub a liberal amount into the wood. Wipe off excess and allow to set overnight before using it.

Cotton Pouch Cleaning

After some usage the jute pouch may need to be cleaned too. You can easily handwash it with warm soapy water. The pouch can also safely be cold washed in the washing machine.



RECYCLING YOUR CUTLERY

When your bamboo utensils wear off and need to be replaced, you can dispose of them directly into the compost. The cutlery is biodegradable and will safely return to the soil.

The pouch lasts longer than the cutlery. You can give a second life to the pouch by using it for your other cutlery. You can also repurchase Bambaw's refill cutlery and store it in your pouch.
