

(OR) MAYA FULL CHISEL CARBIDE

WARNING: Maya (OR) Full Chisel is a non-safety chain capable of kick-back. Use only if you're a trained and experienced chainsaw operator.

Carbide-tipped saw chains are specifically developed for longer cutting-edge life, resulting in less frequent sharpening. Carbide cuts approximately 4-5 times more wood per sharpen than conventional steel chain.

Maya large cutter full chisel carbide is a medium cutting speed chain, designed for cutting green wood or medium density hardwood with greater than 15% moisture content. It's also suited for cutting dirty or treated wood, burnt logs, stumping etc, but contacting contaminants, hard objects, dirt, termite sand, rock, steel will most likely damage cutter or carbide tip shortening chains lifespan.

Sharpening: Carbide is an extremely hard compound, approximately twice the density of steel. Degrease chain to remove any oil first then sharpen carbide with discs or files coated with diamond after every 4-5 tanks of fuel.

Please note: If you are proposing to cut dense hardwood, grey/yellow box, gidgee, ironbark, buloke, red mahogany, turpentine, etc.
(OR) full chisel carbide pictured above is Not Suitable we recommend Maya (ST) round cutter carbide pictured below or a conventional steel chain.
