## Cutting Instructions

- One block Requires: Light Fabric (A): $1-5^{1 / 2 \prime \prime} \times 5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}, \underline{6-3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}}$ squares.

Medium Fabric (B): $4-\underline{21 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 6 "}$ rectangles.
Dark Fabric (C): 1-51/2" $\times 5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}, 4-3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ and $1-\underline{2} 18^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{1^{\prime \prime}}$ squares.

| Assorted Medium Prints (B) <br> 1-6" $\times$ WOF strip yields units for 5 blocks. Topper uses half width strips. | Cut 2 different 6" x 20" strips. Cut each strip into: $8-21 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 6 \text { " }$ <br> (Need 4 sets of 4 ) | Cut 5 different 6" strips. Cut each strip into 16-21/8" $\times 6^{\prime \prime}$ (Need 20 sets of 4) | Cut 11 different 6" strips.
