CARE INSTRUCTIONS FOR CHROME PLATED CASES

With proper care, the chrome plating on your case will last for many years with no noticeable signs of deterioration. Following these care instructions will prolong the life of your chrome plated case.

- Keep the case free of dust and moisture. We have found that dust, when mixed with moisture created by humidity, can destroy the plating.
- 2. All finger prints should be wiped off immediately.
- 3. If any water, particularly salt water, comes in contact with the chrome finish, immediately wipe it dry.
- 4. The case should be cleaned regularly with a mild, non-abrasive, soapy rinse, then thoroughly dried. After washing, apply a coat of clear, non-abrasive, car wax. The wax coating will keep moisture from penetrating the chrome plating.
- 5. If the instrument will be used on board a boat, we recommend the use of a "Solar Fan Vent*" in your boat. This will not only prolong the life of your instrument, but everything else on board as well. We strongly suggest that the instrument be removed from your boat during long periods of non-use.
- * Sun activated deck fan which exhausts stagnant cabin air.
