
PART ONE: BUILDING THE FRAME

WOVEN#1 / SHADE ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS






Components

- **1.** (24 x Ribs)
- **2.** (6 x Wings)
- **3.** (28 x Rivets)
- 4. (1 x Suspension Star)
- (1 x Ceiling Canopy)(26 x Rimu Leaves)



Join the ribs using the slots beneath the coloured dots.




Assembly Steps


Place the ribs on a flat surface covered with a towel or similar.



You will have created a wishbone shape.



Select a blue dot rib and an orange dot rib.



4. Connect a second blue dot rib to the left hand side of the wishbone. Join this new rib one slot up from the wishbone joint and one slot up from the blue dot.






Add an orange dot rib to the blue dot rib, removing coloured dots before connecting.




You will now have three joints and four ribs.




Keep repeating these steps to build the circular shape of the frame.




You can partially join slots to help align the ribs.




Some joints may need a wiggle and a firm push to snap flush.




When you have nearly used up all the ribs, ensure the outward-facing slots <u>are inside</u> the inwardfacing slots.




Slightly compress the frame to help align the slots.




A small torsional twist may help some ribs join together. *Avoid excessive twisting; maximum 5 degrees.




Ensure all ribs are connected, with twelve connections top and bottom.



Find any joints that have 'popped loose' and are no longer flush.




Push together any loose joints. *Some joints may require a 'firm push' to help them 'snap' flush.



Well done! The frame is assembled.

PART TWO: WEAVING THE RIMU LEAF






Preparing for Weaving

Ensure the bottom of the frame is on the work surface. Identify the bottom by the joints that run in the opposite direction to all other joints.



Push the leaf through the last rib, ensuring the top edge of the leaf slots into the parallel rib above.



Rimu Leaf Weaving Steps

Start at the top; thread a Rimu leaf through the slots.



the white fabric sides are facing inward - for all of the Rimu leaves weaved into the frame.



Return to the top, pull the leaf back so the bottom edge of the leaf slots into the parallel rib below.

*Please note; Excessive bending of the Rimu leaf can split the timber.



Thread a second Rimu leaf in the same direction.





Repeat steps 21. & 22. for all leaves.




Keep threading Rimu leaves until all slots are filled in one direction (12 leaves).



Add a new leaf in the opposite direction. Start by threading it <u>over</u> the existing leaf.



Then thread it under - over - under - over - under - over, to create a weave.



For each leaf don't forget to repeat steps 21. & 22.



Keep threading each new Rimu leaf **over - under - over** etc., from top to bottom, to build the weave effect.




Use 24 Rimu leaves, with two spares left over.



Check you have a consistent weave pattern for the entire pendant before proceeding to the next step.



Components
28 x Rivets (28 x joining and 28 x receiving).



Rivet Connection

Line up the pre-drilled rivet holes at the top and bottom of the Rimu leaves



Select a joining rivet and a receiving rivet.



Insert joining rivet from outside.






Add receiving rivet inside. Use your finger and thumb to snap together.



Apply pressure to one side of the rivet to help snap together. Listen for a 'click': One click good, two clicks best.




Connect 12 rivets at the top and 12 at the bottom; 4 spares left. **Well done!** The pendant shade is assembled.

PART THREE: ASSEMBLING THE SUSPENSION STAR




Components

1 x Suspension Star 6 x Wings



Assembly Steps

Connect each wing to the suspension star.




Ensure wing mouths face upward.






Push each wing fully into the suspension star.



Place the suspension star and wings inside the top of the pendant shade.



Insert the mouth of each wing into every second cross joint.



Ensure the bottom of each wing mouth supports the pendant shade.



Congratulations! The Woven#1 pendant is now assembled and ready to be hung from the ceiling canopy.
