



# PLEASE NOTE THAT THE FOLLOWING PICTURES ARE BASED ON THE PASSENGER SIDE INSTALLATION

## STEP 1


Starting from underneath the Passenger/Right body panel. Locate the front factory mounting location along the inner side of the body, **(Fig 1)**. Use a wire brush or thread chaser die to remove excess paint and/or undercoating from two studs.

## STEP 2


Select the (1) Passenger/Right Mounting Bracket. Attach the Bracket to the front location with (2) 8mm Flat Washers and (2) 8mm Flange Nuts, (Fig 2). Do not tighten hardware.



(Fig 2) Attach (1) Passenger/Right Mounting Bracket to the front location


#### STEP 3

Repeat **Steps 2** to attach (2) Passenger/Right Mounting Brackets to the center and rear locations, **(Figs 3 - 4)**. Do not tighten hardware.



(Fig 3) Passenger/Right center mounting location






#### STEP 4

Select the Passenger/Right Running Board.

NOTE: Please identify the Passenger/Right
Running Board according to the illustration on
Part List. Carefully place Running Board on the
brackets. IMPORTANT: Do not slide the Running
Board front to back or damage to the finish may
result. Attach Running Board to the Mounting
Brackets with (6) 8mm Combo Bolts, (Fig 5). Do
not tighten hardware.



(Fig 5) Attach the Passenger/Right Running Board to the Mounting Brackets

## STEP 5

Level and adjust the Running Board and fully tighten all hardware.

# STEP 6

Repeat **Steps 1—5** to attach the Driver/Left Running Board.

## STEP 7

Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

#### **Attention**

To protect your investment, do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish.

Mild soap may be used also to clean the Running Boards.
