













(Fig 4) Diver/Left rear mounting location



#### STEP 4

Select the Driver/Left Running Board. **NOTE:** Please identify the Driver/Left Running Board according to the illustration on Part List. Carefully place Running Board on the brackets. **IMPORTANT:** Do not slide the Running Board front to back or damage to the finish may result. Attach Running Board to the (3) Mounting Brackets with (6) 8mm Combo Bolts, **(Fig 6)**. Do not tighten hardware.

#### STEP 5

Level and adjust the Running Board and fully tighten all hardware.

## STEP 6

Repeat **Steps 1—5** to attach the Passenger/Right Running Board.

### STEP 7

Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

#### Attention

To protect your investment, do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish.

Mild soap may be used also to clean the Running Boards.
