



# PLEASE NOTE THAT THE FOLLOWING PICTURES ARE BASED ON THE PASSENGER SIDE INSTALLATION

#### STEP 1


Start the installation under the Passenger/Right side of the vehicle. Locate the front mounting location along the bottom and inner side of the body panel, (Fig 1). Installation will use the 1st, 2nd and 4th mounting locations. NOTE: It may help to hold a Bracket up in place to help determine the mounting holes to use along the bottom and inner side of the body.

#### STEP 2




(Fig 2) Remove plugs from mounting locations as necessary

Remove rubber plugs as necessary from the holes in the side and bottom of the inner body panel, (Fig 2).

# STEP 3






(Fig 3) Slide 8mm Clip Nut into large hole and over small hole

Select (2) 8mm Clip Nuts. Slide each Clip Nut into the large hole and over the smaller hole next to it. Line up threaded nut on the Clip Nut with smaller hole in body panel, **(Fig 3)**

## STEP 4

Select (1) Mounting Bracket. Attach the Mounting Bracket to the (2) Clip Nuts in the vehicle with (2) 8mm Hex Bolts, (2) 8mm Lock Washers and (2) 8mm Flat Washers, (Fig 4). Do not tighten hardware.

# STEP 5




(Fig 6) Remove rubber plugs from the Passenger/Right rear mounting location

Repeat **Steps 1 - 4** to attach the remaining (2) Mounting Bracket to the 2nd and rear locations, **(Figs 5 & 6)**. Do not tighten hardware.



(Fig 5) Remove rubber plugs from the Passenger/Right center mounting location




# STEP 6

Select the Passenger/Right Side Step. **NOTE:** The Passenger/Right Side Step have a **Sticker** "P" on the front. Insert (6) 6mm T-Bolts into the channels in the bottom of the Side Step, **(Fig 7)**, (3 T-Bolts per channel). Attach the Side Step to the (3) Mounting Brackets with (6) 6mm Flat Washers, (6) 6mm Lock Washers and (6) 6mm Hex Nuts, **(Fig 8)**. Do not tighten hardware.

#### **Attention**

To protect your investment, do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish.

Mild soap may be used also to clean the Side Steps.

#### STEP 7

Level and adjust the Side Step and fully tighten all hardware.

## STEP 8

Repeat **Steps 1—7** to attach the Driver/Left Side Step.

#### STEP 9

Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.
