



PLEASE NOTE THAT THE FOLLOWING PICTURES ARE BASED ON THE PASSENGER SIDE INSTALLATION

STEP 1


Starting from underneath the Passenger/Right body panel. Locate the front factory mounting location along the inner side of the body, **(Fig 1)**. Use a wire brush or thread chaser die to remove excess paint and/or undercoating from two studs.

STEP 2


Select the (1) Mounting Bracket. Attach the Bracket to the Passenger/Right front location with (2) 8mm Flat Washers and (2) 8mm Flange Nuts, (Fig 2). Do not tighten hardware.



(Fig 2) Attach (1) Mounting Bracket to the Passenger/Right front location


STEP 3

Repeat **Steps 1-2** to attach (2) Mounting Brackets to the Passenger/Right center and rear locations, **(Figs 3-4)**. Do not tighten hardware.



(Fig 3) Passenger/Right center mounting location







STEP 4

Select the Passenger/Right Side Step. Insert (6) 6mm T-Bolts into the slots underneath the Side Step (Fig 5). NOTE: The Passenger/Right Side Step will have a Sticker "P" on the front.

IMPORTANT: Do not slide the Side Step front to back or damage to the finish may result. Attach the Side Step to the (3) Mounting Brackets with (6) 6mm Flat Washers, (6) 6mm Lock Washers, and (6) 6mm Hex Nuts **(Fig 6)**. Do not tighten hardware.



(Fig 5) Insert (6) 6mm T-Bolts into the channels in the bottom of the Side Step, (3 T-Bolts per channel)



STEP 5

Mounting Brackets

Level and adjust the Side Step and fully tighten all hardware.

STEP 6

Repeat **Steps 1—5** to attach the Driver/Left Side Step.

STEP 7

Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

Attention

To protect your investment, do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish.

Mild soap may be used also to clean the Side Steps.
