## **Dungeon Tile Care Instructions**

Role 4 Initiative Dungeon Tiles are compatible with practically any dry-erase, wet-erase, or liquid chalk marker. We have tested over 30 different brands of markers, allowing them to dry for over 30 days, and all came off just fine with no damage or staining to the tiles. For high-contrast on dark-colored tiles, we recommend liquid chalk markers. Liquid chalk and wet-erase markers are also great if you'll be drawing a map you'd like to leave on the tiles for long periods of time. Once they dry, the maps can easily be piled up and transported without staining or orasing your tiles.

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
For dry-erasing, we recommend any brand of magic eraser or melamine foam, but generic whiteboard erasers also work.

For wet-erasing, just a damp cloth or paper towel should do fine.

If a certain type of ink is being stubborn in its removal, try using some rubbing alcohol. We can't recommend using permanent marker on Dungeon Tiles, but rubbing alcohol combined with a magic eraser can wipe it away. If using either wet-erase or permanent markers, you can try writing over them with a dry-erase marker first and then using an eraser and rubbing alcohol.

When removing wet-erase ink, avoid spraying water directly on the tiles. The surface is water-resistant, but liquids can enter through the sides and damage the tiles. Instead, moisten a cloth and use that to clean off wet-erase ink in order to ensure longevity of your Dungeon Tiles.
