


2-4 Digital Wireless DVR Quick Start Guide



Please read this quick start guide thoroughly before operating the device, and keep it for future reference.


Parts Identification



- Press CH- button to enter menu item or save user settings.
- Press CH- button - shortcut for start/stop recording.
- Press CH- button for 3 seconds - shortcut for PAIRING.




Power cable



Installation of U-support Bracket






AUTO BATTERY HARD WIRE CONNECTION SETUP

(most common but could vary based on preference)

Powering Monitor and Digital Camera's

- Only the black (ground) and red (power) is needed for system to work. The colored wires are used for a custom install with triggers.(colored wires are not typically used)
- Individually wrap wire tips with electrical tape on all other colored wires so that they do not touch metal and cause interference.
- Connect ground and positive wires to auto battery and connect other end to LCD monitor.
- Connect only the quick disconnect cable to a power source.
- Do not connect the quick connect cable from the camera until instructed below.

Remote Control Functions



2 Camera Pairing Setup

Using remote: To Enter Menu Settings, You must ALWAYS be in SINGLE CAM View

1. Press Menu
2. Highlight "Mode" (it will be in yellow when highlighted)
3. Press Ok
4. Select Split "1-2" Mode
5. Press OK and wait until screen is black
6. Using the "SEL" button – press until you see CAM1 on top left corner of LCD monitor screen.

The screen will be solid black.

7. Press "PAIR" on remote and then connect power disconnect cable to camera quick connect cable.
8. Once camera is recording, press "SEL" button until you see a black screen that says CAM2 on the top left of screen.
9. Press "PAIR" on remote and then connect power disconnect cable to camera quick connect cable.
10. Once camera is recording, press "SEL" to navigate between cameras and to display a split screen.

3-4 Camera Pairing Setup

Using remote: To Enter Menu Settings, You must ALWAYS be in SINGLE CAM View

1. Press Menu
2. Highlight "Mode" (it will be in yellow when highlighted)
3. Press Ok
4. Using "Vol" right arrow button
5. Navigate to highlight "QUAD" Mode
6. Press OK - and wait until screen is black
7. Press the "SEL" button – press until you see CAM1 on top left corner of LCD monitor screen.

The screen will be solid black.

8. Press "PAIR" on remote and then connect power disconnect cable to camera quick connect cable.
9. Once camera is recording, press "SEL" button until you see a black screen that says CAM2 on the top left of screen.
10. Repeat for cameras 3 and 4
11. Once camera is recording, press "SEL" to navigate between cameras and to display a "QUAD" mode screen
