

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20 and 64 Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

ARLA Ref: **50/OF/014/2019**
DLC Ref: **OF116**

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 ("the Act"), **Eddyline Brewery & Pizzeria NZ Ltd** (the licensee) is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at **8 Champion Road**, Nelson and known as "Eddyline Brewery & Pizzeria" to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises. The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. **HOURS** -

- a. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Sunday -11.00 am to 10.00 pm

- b. No alcohol is to be sold on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1pm on Anzac Day to any person who is not:
- i. residing or lodging on the premises; or
 - ii. present on the premises to dine.

2. **FOOD** - A range of food choices must be readily available at reasonable prices at all times that the premises are open. Menus must be visible and food should be actively promoted. A minimum of three types of food should be available. The range or style of food will be as shown on any menu submitted.

3. **WATER** - Drinking water must be freely available in the following location: At the bar on request or self-service from a container on the bar.

4. **NON/LOW ALCOHOL DRINKS** - A range of non-alcoholic and low-alcoholic drinks must be readily available at reasonable prices.

5. **TRANSPORT** - Information relating to safe transport options must be readily available to customers.

6. **DESIGNATED AREAS** - The following parts of the premises is designated as:

- **1 Metre around bar - Supervised**
- **Balance of the premises- Undesignated**

7. **SIGNAGE** - Signage must be displayed at each point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.


8. **RESTRICTIONS** - The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

The applicant's attention is drawn to Sections 56, 57 and 214 of the Act which requires the holder of an OFF Licence to display:

1. A sign attached to the premises, so as to be easily read by persons outside each principal entrance, stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol; and,
2. A copy of the licence, and of the conditions of the licence, attached to the inside of the premises so as to be easily read by persons entering through each principal entrance; and
3. A sign prominently displayed inside the premises, which identifies the full name of the manager for the time being on duty.
