

RING SIZE GUIDE


IMPORTANT STEPS TO ASSURE THE MOST ACCURATE MEASUREMENT

Before printing this ring size guide, ensure that Page Scaling is set to "100%" on your print dialog box. To check the accuracy of your print, simply compare your print-out on the line below to ensure it is exactly 2 inches. They should match up precisely in order to use this ring size guide properly.



Option 1 - Measure an Existing Ring

To distinguish your ring size, use an existing ring that fits your desired finger. Place the ring over the circles below. Make sure to match the inside edge of the ring with the circle and that no maroon spaces are shown. This is the inside diameter of the ring. If the ring falls between two sizes, we recommend you to choose the larger of the two.



Option 2 - Measure with a Cut-out Ruler

Cut out the ruler provided below. Afterwards, carefully cut the line indicated to create a slit. Wrap the ruler around your finger at the base and pull the end through the slit. You can measure your knuckle with the ruler as well to ensure the ring fits perfectly on your finger. Best to select a size that goes on and off your finger easily.
