> Ivey Hayes was an artist who battled the pains of rheumatoid arthritis. It didn't matter if he was on his crutches or in his wheelchair, or if he was painting with his right hand or left, he always had a smile. Through his unwavering positive outlook on life, which was grounded by his strong spirituality, he painted with passion and excitement. Painting allowed him to feel and experience things which otherwise would have been physically difficult. For Hayes, painting was a form of therapy and a major source of happiness.
