


Actual Size of Mesh Holes






Slightly stretchy

Crosswise grain = Most stretch



Lengthwise grain = Less stretch





Adds no bulk

Quilted fabric with quilted fabric pocket = 4 layers fabric, 2 layers Soft and Stable



Quilted fabric with mesh pocket = 2 layers fabric, 1 layer mesh 1 layer Soft and Stable = LESS BULK





Easy to sew



Cut mesh larger Pin/clip in place




Sew with mesh on top, fabric on bottom



Finish raw edges with fabric binding

1. Cut fabric 2" x length of mesh



2. Fold binding in half (WST); pin (don't press)





Finish edges with fabric binding

3. Sew 1/4" seam, mesh on top

4. Press seam to binding using pressing tool





Finish edges with fabric binding


5. Fold binding to front and stitch along folded edge






Finish edges with fold-over elastic

1. Cut fold-over elastic to length of mesh




2. Open elastic; place raw edge of mesh along fold





Finish edges with fold-over elastic

3. Fold elastic over mesh; stitch along edge of elastic




'Right' side out = shiny

'Wrong' side out = matte



Finish edges with fold-over elastic

4. Gather mesh by stretching elastic as you sew




Pull tighter = more gathers

Pull slightly = less gathers




Finish edges with French seam


1. Sew ¼" seam, right sides out; press seam to one side



2. Turn wrong side out, sew ¼" seam




3. Turn right side out






Attach zipper, bound edge

1. Bind edge of mesh pocket



2. Attach basting tape to back of binding





Attach zipper, bound edge

3. Position pocket on zipper; sew along top and bottom edges of binding





Attach zipper directly to mesh

- 1. Position mesh on zipper, WRONG sides together
- 2. Sew zipper to pocket with ¼" seam





Attach zipper directly to mesh

- 3. Finger-press zipper tape to front of pocket
- 4. Sew along very edge of zipper tape



Sewn with contrasting thread for visibility. Use matching thread for actual project.
