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# ETHIOPIA

We have been working on this project, based in the Simien Mountains, for almost a year. This is by far our largest scale project with the potential to impact thousands of lives. The aim of the initiative is a locally run sanitation business, headed by Ethiopian entrepreneur Banti. The business will create and supply culturally appropriate latrines to the remote villages of the mountains, improving their sanitation leading to healthier communities and reduced childhood mortality.

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# G A M B I A

Moussa is a potter and an entrepreneur. He has designed and created an eco-friendly clay lined stove which he sells in the local community. The stove is made using sustainable materials and it requires less wood to light therefore saving money, time and energy for the women who buy it. Expanding Moussa's business will allow more families to benefit from his stoves, as well as creating more jobs in the area and skills training for the women's collective which he supports.



# SEAMSTRESS SCHOOL

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# MALI

This seamstress school in Bamako, Mali, is the first of its kind in Bamako. It was created in order to provide opportunities for those fleeing the war-torn north of the country. As well as providing education and training, Alain ensures that his students are placed in jobs so they can use their new skills to provide for their families and escape the poverty trap. This fantastic project was launched in late 2019 and is already training 37 women. It has also created 5 jobs within the school itself.
