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## Requirements

| White $100 \%$ cotton <br> fabric | 1.5 m | 2 m | 2.7 m | 3 m | 3.35 m |
| Embroiders felt (if you <br> choose to use - but <br> recommended) 150 cm <br> wide | 1.2 m | 1.4 m | 1.6 m | 1.7 m | 2.2 m |
| Wadding (based on <br> 150mm wide) | 1.2 m | 1.4 m | 1.6 m | 1.7 m | 2.2 m |
| Backing Fabric | 1.5 m | 2 m | 2.7 m | 3 m | 3.35 m |
| Applique fabric -4 <br> different colours | Fat quarter <br> each | Fat quarter <br> each | 30 cm each | 40 cm each | $1 / 2 \mathrm{~m}$ each |

- Embroidery Threads - you will need one colour for each different applique fabric plus white for quilting
- Washaway Thread
- Stabiliser (I recommend polymesh for this project, as it is soft and thin, and won't be felt in the finished project
- Bobbin Fill - you will need lots of this.....
- sharp curved tip scissors for trimming your applique (I recommend the squeeze scissors from Julie Hall Designs)

Preparing your blocks...
Cut your main block fabrics, ready for stitching

|  | 5" blocks | 6" blocks | 7" blocks | 8" blocks | 9" blocks |

| White 100\% cotton fabric | 7x7" | 8x8" | 9x9" | 10x10" | 11x11" |
| Embroiders felt | 7x7" | 8x8" | 9x9" | $10 \times 10$ " | 11x11" |
| Wadding (based on 150 mm wide) | 7x7" | 8x8" | 9x9" | $10 \times 10$ " | 11x11" |
| Backing Fabric | 7x7" | 8x8" | 9x9" | $10 \times 10$ " | 11x11" |
| Applique fabric - 4 different colours | 7x7" | 8x8" | 9x9" | $10 \times 10$ " | 11x11" |

Iron all of your fabrics.
Starch your main $100 \%$ cotton fabric with ironing starch
You are now ready to begin your quilt......
