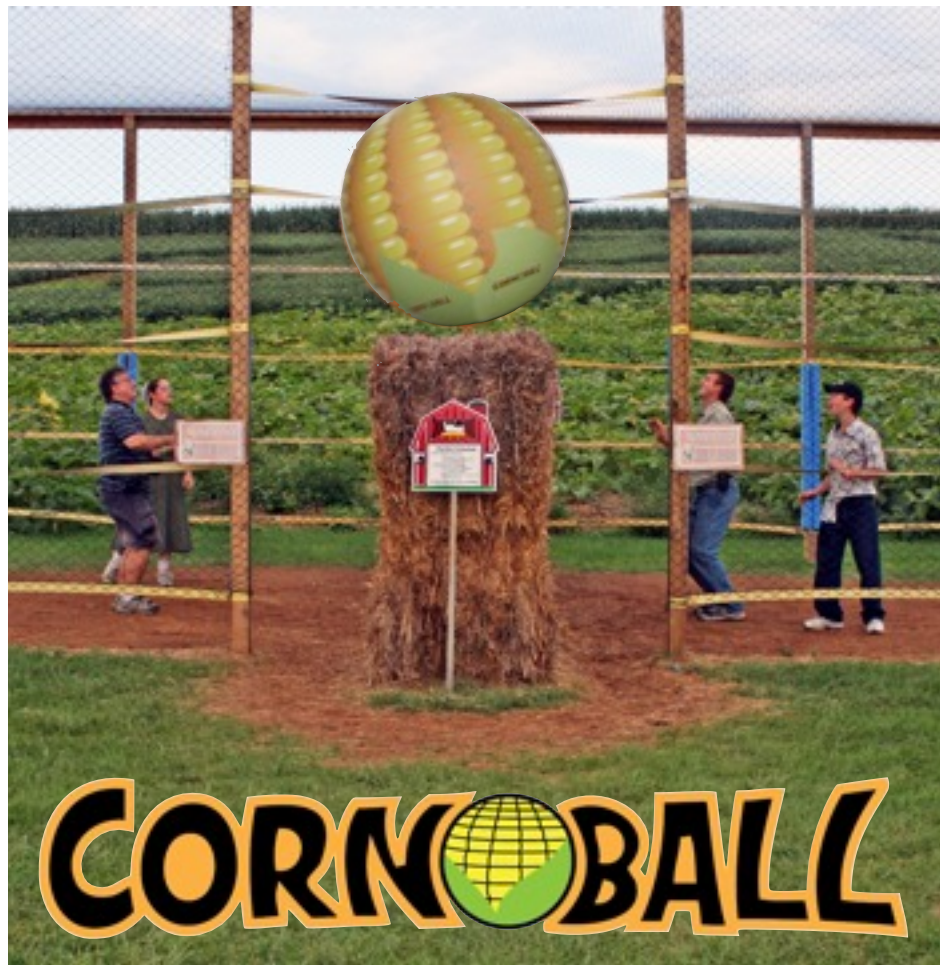

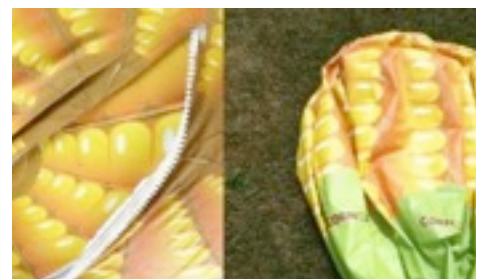

## You Will Need

- Netting: 120' long x 12' high
- 13 Posts: 4"x6"x16' (Posts)
- 8 Side/Top Plate: 2"x6"x20'
- 5 Side/Top Plate: 2"x6"x16'
- 125 1" Eyelets
- 125 Carabiners

The netting is a 4" block volleyball type netting.

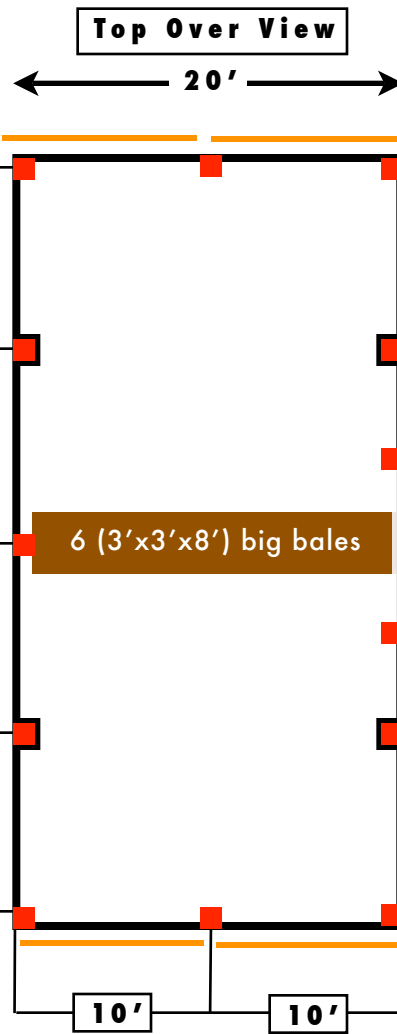
The netting that they will sell you has been designed just for the CornBall court. Ropes will be placed around the edges of the netting as well as every 10 feet. The built-in ropes will align right with the posts which are spaced every 10 feet as well. Having the ropes placed like this will give extra strength to your netting.

### ENTRANCE

Pull back the netting around the entrance on each side (like curtains on a stage). Simply use a carabiner to hold the netting in place.

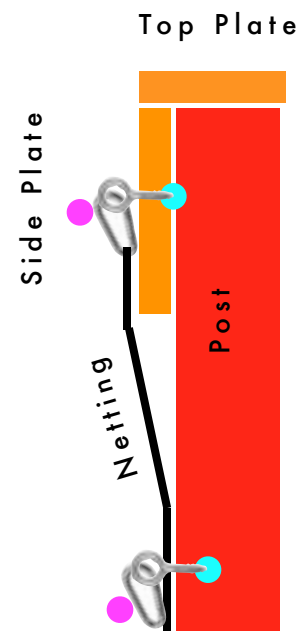
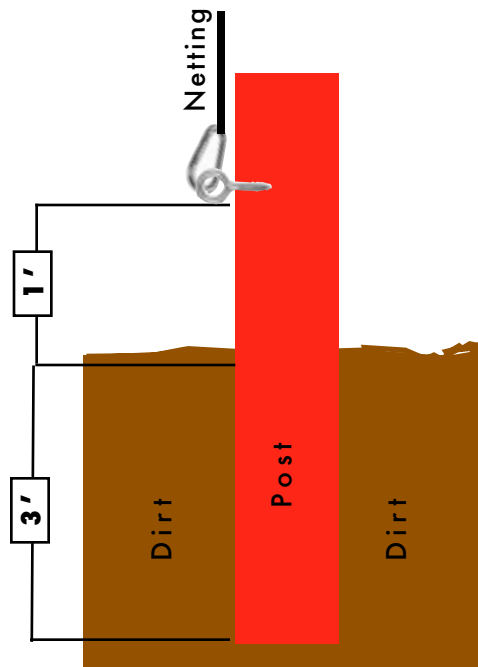
### BOTTOM

Leave 1 foot of open space between the ground and netting. This foot of space will allow you to easily mow under the netting (if needed) and keep people from stepping on it.
