MAIZE-O-Poly

HOW TO PLAY

The goal of MAiZE-O-POLY is for your customer to earn as much "imaginary" money as they can. Your customers make money by finding signs inside the maze and punching their game card with the punch attached to the sign. Each hole puncher is unique and matches the separate game board properties. The more punched properties, the more money they will make. If they earn less than \$20,000 they will be a bankrupt farmer. Earn \$20,000 or more and they will be an amazing farmer; and if they make \$46,500+, they will be Farmer of the Earl

TIPS:

- Adding signs to paths less traveled will make the game more difficult.
- MAiZE-O-POLY is very educational and appeals to field trip groups.
- Having a prize for the "Farmer of The Ear" award is a great incentive
- Your guests can play MAiZE-O-POLY both inside the corn maze and out, depending on where you place your signs.



Attach Hole Punches

- Attach HD hole punch with stainless steel chain to post, just below sign
- Use 3/8" lag bolt that is 2 1/2" long with flat washer

- Dig a hole at least 18" deep
- Make sure "notches" are below ground level



- Spinning wheel should be accessible to little kids



Hang Banners


- Hang 4' x 8' Instructional Banner at maze entrance

HOW TO PLAY

Everyone is a winner in Simon Says. The goal of this game is for your guests to be goofy and have fun. The guest spins the wheel and then the group performs whatever action is landed on (i.e., skip and sing E.I.E.I.O., walk with knees together and clap your hands, etc.) This is a game for kiddie mazes and could be called the "10-minute Ultimate Corn Maze Adventure".

TIPS:

- There is no required number of wheels to play this game, but the more wheels, the more fun!
- Because you will likely have a small number of these wheels in your maze, this game can easily be combined with another game in the same maze OR be used in a small kiddie maze.





HOW TO PLAY

Spin for Adventure is not as much a game, as it is an interactive tool that can help to promote the many activities you have on your farm. Each space on the wheel contains an attraction or event specific to your farm and guests can enjoy spinning the wheel to see what fun activity they'll go do next. More than anything, this is a way of making sure your guests know the many different attractions you offer while also giving them the added fun spinning a wheel (little ones especially love this!)

TIPS:

 This wheel will be customized to your farm, so that it includes whatever attractions/events you want printed on it.



Corn Text

HOW TO PLAY

Corntext is an interactive game that allows a customer to text for clues while they navigate the maze. Text message clues are relayed back to the customer's cell phone in seconds. Post as few or as many signs in the maze as desired. When a customer approaches a sign, they will text the word on the sign to a number displayed below the word. CornText clues can be customized to any maze theme. You can also use CornText to time people through the maze, send maps to cell phones and conduct raffles for giveaways. Cell numbers are stored so you can send them messages at a future date.

TIPS:

 The CornText service can be used as an interactive game, marketing tool and as an employee communication channel.

HOW TO PLAY

Cornundrums give customers the opportunity to solve a silly "conundrum" or riddle each time they encounter a sign in your maze or on your property. For example, the correct answer for the sign pictured to the right is Pigs in a Blanket. As the farm owner, you have the flexibility of posting as many, or as few, signs as you like. There is no required number of signs needed to implement this game. As an optional upgrade, you can order and distribute Cornundrum Prize cards, where customers mark off which cornundrums they solved on your farm and then provide their contact info for the prize drawing (which you can use for future marketing communication.)

TIPS:

 Signs can be placed in maze only or throughout whole farm (i.e., pigs in a blanket could be placed near your pig races, corn dog could be placed near concessions, etc.)






SIGN SET UP

- 1.Cut a notch into bottom of post.
- 2.Cut plywood and bevel edges.
- 3.Dig hole
- 4.Attach plywood to post.
- 5.Attach sign to plywood.

TIPS:

- Buy rough-cut or treated posts.
- Make sure screws do not poke out the back of posts or plywood.





Passports

HOW TO PLAY

Passports were the first interactive game we introduced and they continue to be the most popular and widely used within the MAiZE family. One of the greatest benefits of passports is that there are 15 specialized topics, allowing groups who visit your maze (i.e, churches, scouts, 4H groups, field trips, corporate teambuilding etc.) to feel like you have something specifically geared toward enhancing their experience. Customers select one of the passport topics you make available to them at the maze entrance and answer a question every time they encounter a numbered sign inside the maze. If they choose the correct answer, the passports tell them the correct direction to turn. If they choose the wrong answer, it will direct them to turn the wrong way.

TIPS:

 Answers are printed on the back corner, upside down, and it's good to tell your customers about this, giving them the freedom to look at answers if they want an easier experience.



Distribute Passports

 Distribute passports at maze entrance (one per group or family). Some farms do this manually, having an employee give out the desired passport. Other farms have the passports available for the public to take their own (in mailbox displays, etc.)

Barnyard Bingo

HOW TO PLAY

The goal of Barnyard Bing-Oh is to scratch off 5 barnyard animals in a row, without unveiling any skunks. To earn a super prize, guests could go a step further and unveil all 19 non-skunk squares. To make sure they are scratching off the "safe" squares, guests should find your 10 posted-Bingo signs, letting them know which squares are safe to scratch. Signs can be placed throughout your maze OR around your farm.

TIPS:

- Adding signs to paths less traveled will make the game more difficult.
- Your guests can play both inside the corn maze and/or out, depending on where you place your signs.

HOW TO PLAY

The goal of the SELFIE SCAVENGER HUNT game is to post signs around your farm, inviting guests to take & post selfies of random photo opps (i.e., with the biggest pumpkin they can find, at the exit of your corn maze, etc.) Each sign is customized to include your farm's logo, hashtag, and what you plan to offer as a prize to your scavenger hunt winner that you select.

TIPS:

- Prizes could be offered weekly or at the conclusion of your season...it's up to you!
- The better the prize and the more signs you post around the farm, the better the social media posting frequency will likely be.

- Having a prize for the "Farmer of The Ear" award is a great incentive
- Your guests can play MAiZE-O-POLY both inside the corn maze and out, depending on where you place your signs.

THE DETAILS

Purchase Balls

- **Footballs**: One option for footballs is to use the "cornthemed" footballs sold on the MAiZE shopping cart, or any other football you prefer. You will need some steel rings, or something similar, to screw onto the banners after they are installed. The rings cover the perimeter of each hole, protecting them from tearing or sagging.
- Baseballs: Because there is a risk of balls bouncing back and possibly hitting someone, you'll want to make sure you get something softer than a typical baseball. Some farms use a soft-core tee-ball, while others use an orange pitching machine baseball or softball. Search on Amazon for cheapest price.
- **Basketballs**: The best supplier we have found is carnivaltoys.com. They sell 7" mini balls for \$36/dozen. If you like, a jack-o-lantern face can be drawn on with a marker.
- Basketball Rims: The rims we purchased for Cornbelly's were the Spalding Standard Rims on Amazon for \$34.99 ea.

3 Steel Rings

- You will need some steel rings (approx. 1/4" thick and 3/4" wide), or something similar, to screw onto the banners after they are installed. The rings cover the perimeter of each hole, protecting them from tearing or sagging. We used four carriage bolts per ring to secure them to the banner/plywood. We recommend first bolting the rings on, then cut the holes into the plywood with a sawzall after the rings are secured.
 - The diameter of the holes are:
 - a. Baseball: 5 inches, 6.5, 7, 9, 12 inches
 - b. Football: 9 inches, 10 inches, 11 inches, 12 inches





HOW TO PLAY

Mr. Pumpkin Head & Friends is an interactive game (like a life-size Mr. Potato Head) that you can set up anywhere on the farm. There are 6 body options (approx. 4 feet tall) & 3 sets of accessory options. Guests will have a great time interchanging the magnetized eyes, noses, mouths and hats to create their own characters.

TIPS:

- You will want to build some kind of box or container to hold your accessories.
- · We recommend building a frame to secure your body to.
- In your off season, we recommend storing these items in a safe, dry location with moderate temperatures.

HOW TO PLAY

Cluck-O, Apple-O, Corn-O, Donut-O, and Pumpkin-O are fun, interactive games (similar to Plinko) that can be placed anywhere on the farm.

We don't have any building plans, but are happy to show you a few pictures of the one we built. It will require building a structure with stairs, with a face that has plexiglass covering the banner and bolts placed where each dot on the banner is. Essentially it operates just like Plinko.
