

## HEADSHOT TIPS | HOW TO PREPARE

CLOTHING	<ul> <li>Bring:         <ul> <li>Several outfits that you feel great wearing and more than you think you need, to provide a variety of options to find the best look</li> <li>Well fitted clothing, because loose or bagging clothing can be distracting</li> <li>Clothes with solid colours and/or limited patterns</li> <li>Shirt with long sleeves (and/or a jacket) are better, to avoid the distraction of your skin below the elbow showing</li> <li>Ties with simple patterns</li> <li>Iron your clothes, please, to help reduce wrinkles</li> </ul> </li> <li>Leave at home         <ul> <li>Clothes with busy patterns</li> <li>Shirts/tops with deep plunging necklines</li> </ul> </li> <li>However, don't worry about this too much, basically, bring clothes that you love to wear and/or how you would normally dress for an important meeting in your industry.</li> </ul>
FACIAL HAIR	<ul> <li>Beard - nicely groomed, No beard - clean, freshly shaven</li> <li>Trim any "extra" eyebrow or nose hairs</li> </ul>
MAKE UP	Keep it simple, natural, and light
HAIR	As you normally style/wear it
JEWELRY	Less is better, as jewelry can be distracting
GLASSES	Bring them, if you have different styles, bring those as well



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
