

## HEADSHOT TIPS | HOW TO PREPARE

### CLOTHING

- Bring several outfits that you feel great wearing and more than you think you need, to provide a variety of options to find the best look
- Well fitted clothing, because loose or bagging clothing can be distracting
- Clothes with solid colours and limited patterns are preferred
- If you don't have a jacket, long sleeves are better, to avoid the distraction of your skin below the elbow showing
- Avoid shirts/tops with deep plunging necklines
- Ties, with simple patterns
- Iron your clothes, please, to help reduce wrinkles

However, don't worry about this too much, basically, bring clothes that you love to wear and/or how you would normally dress for an important meeting in your industry.

### FACE

- If applicable, freshly shaven, if possible
- Trim any "extra" eyebrow or nose hairs

### MAKE UP

- Keep it simple, natural, and clean
- If you use eyeliner, keep it light, or even better, none at all

### HAIR

- As you normally style/wear it

### JEWELRY

- Less is better, as jewelry can be distracting

### GLASSES

- Bring them, if you have different styles, bring those as well
