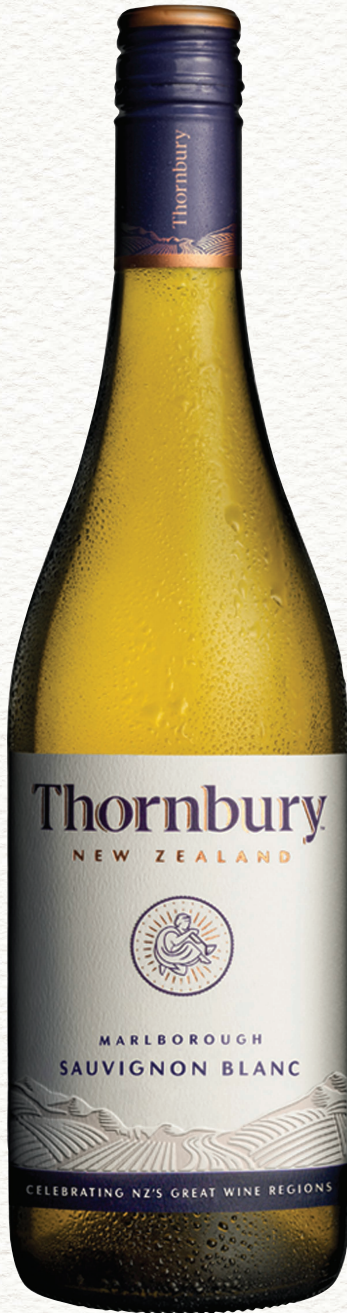

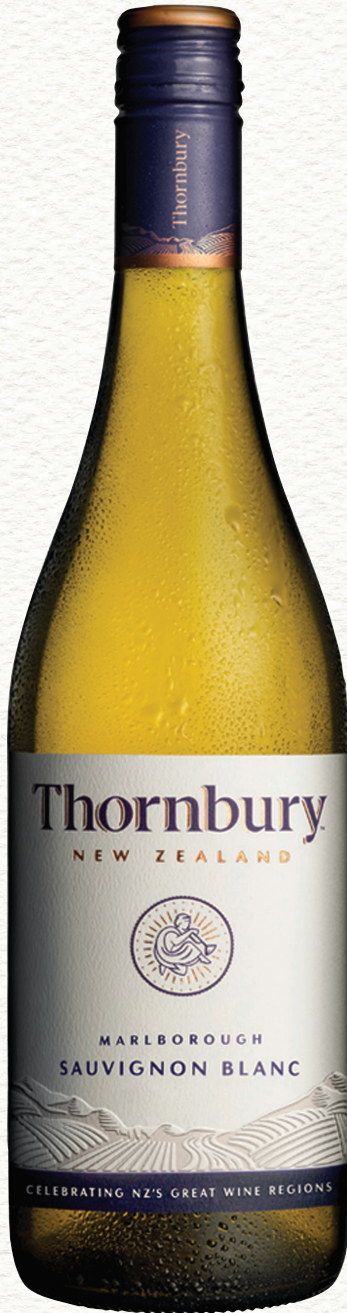

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THE VINEYARD:

The two largest sub-regions in New Zealand - Marlborough's Wairau and Awatere Valleys sit side by side and produce the world's most distinctive Sauvignon Blanc's. This blend of 40% was grown in the Wairau Valley which provides richness and weight along with 60% coming from the cooler Awatere Valley which is famous for its green fruits, finesse and minerality.

WINEMAKING:

Cool fermented in stainless steel tanks using aromatic yeasts. The wine spent time on its yeast lees to lend extra texture and weight.
