| Artwork Is placed on the original dieline that was provided, please do not make changes to tube dimensions. | Separate layers for different customization options have been created. (PRINTING: place all printed elements here; FOIL: place all foil elements here.) |
| All fonts have been converted to outlines to prevent text from being replaced with a different font. | Appropriate swatches from the legend have been used to indicate customization options |
| Important artwork is within the grey safety guidelines. | Make sure to delete unused design elements, guides, or layers. |
| Artwork that is intended to extend past the rolled edges extends through the indicated red bleed lines. The same goes for artwork on the lip. | Save the file using Adobe Illustrator default settings. |
| Externally linked content is embedded that so all graphics are provided in a single file. All non-photo-based elements should be vectorized. | We recommend you print out the artwork on your home printer to reconfirm you're happy with the layout. |
