

Groundhog Headband Instructions

BY ROCK PAPER SPRINKLES

- 1. Using this template, cut headband pieces out of construction paper.
- 2. Staple groundhog head to the middle of a headband strip.
- 3. Add ears, nose, and teeth with tape, glue or staples.
- 4. With markers, draw on the eyes and add decorations.
- 5. Staple a second or third strip to the headband, as needed. Wrap around each child's head to measure, and staple or tape, so it forms a complete circle..
- 6. Wear, enjoy, and "chuck chuck" like an angry groundhog!





Groundhog Headbands


Fold paper in fourths or use this template.

Cut 2 or 3 strips per child.

Groundhog Heads + Ears

- 1. Fold paper in half
- 2. Cut a semi-circle

This will make 2 groundhog heads and 4 ears



Groundhog Cheeks + Nose + Teeth

- 1. Fold paper in half
- 2. Cut out shapes
- 3. Attach teeth, then cheeks, and then the nose

This will make parts for 2 groundhog faces
