• Before cutting, please check that the covering supplied is the correct design, colour and quantity, and is suitable for the design of your furnishing application.

• Pile fabric requires a covering of calico or similar over foam to protect the back of the fabric.

• Natural characteristics of the covering including scar marks in leather, pile shading in velvet, and cotton seeds in loomstate fabrics are not considered a fault.

• Variations in colour and texture may occur due to the irregular nature of yarns, and to the difference between various dye batches.

#### Please review fabric for the most appropriate seam construction, before sewing commences (see below).

- Woven fabric (including Chenilles): recommend 10/12 stitches per 25mm.
- Pile fabric: recommend 8/10 stitches per 25mm.
- While overlocking fabric will assist, using the correct number of stitches per 25mm is critical to the seam performance under stress.
- 20mm minimum selvedge should be taken for sewing.
- Vinyl: recommend 6/7 stitches per 25mm.
- Leather: recommend 6/7 stitches per 25mm.

Where an inappropriate seam construction is used, the Wortley Group Pty Ltd cannot accept responsibility for any seam slippage that may occur.
