Each part is as large as possible and the number of components is as low as possible, reducing frame distortion and power loss. All of this explains why so many Marfix reels from years past are still in use in the field today.

Smooth Lever Drag for Dynamic Control

Modern jigging techniques that use light line to catch big fish require high drag performance. For this reason, many anglers choose lever drag reels. Actions such as releasing and stopping the drag can be done instantly during a fight. However, drags also need to be smooth so you don't lose big fish. Marfix reels are equipped with a large-diameter drag washer that remains smooth even when generating heavy drag force.

Consistent Winding for Maximum Efficiency

With a single handle turn, anglers can effortlessly control their jig, offering versatility in slow pitch scenarios. Marfix sets the maximum line retrieve per crank for all of their reels to 100cm (~39in), providing a consistent standard that enhances fishing outcomes. The carefully designed gear ratio ensures efficient retrieval without overwhelming the angler.

The “Marfix style,” characterized by its commitment to durability, versatile drag performance, and carefully crafted gear ratios, continues to deliver memorable fishing experiences in a compact and efficient package.
