On sunny days

Between 10am and 3am

Early Fall and Spring

Timothy, Orchard grass, Tall Fescue, Kentucky Bluegrass, Perennial Ryegrass

Short grass, overgrazing, drought, frost, lack of nutrients in soil, overgrown pastures w/ grasses gone to seed

SUGAR IS LOWER

On cloudy days

Early morning 3am-10am

Winter

Bermuda grass, Bahia grass, Crab Grass, Teff & Alfalfa (not a grass)

Long grass, well-watered grass, shaded grass, dormant grass
