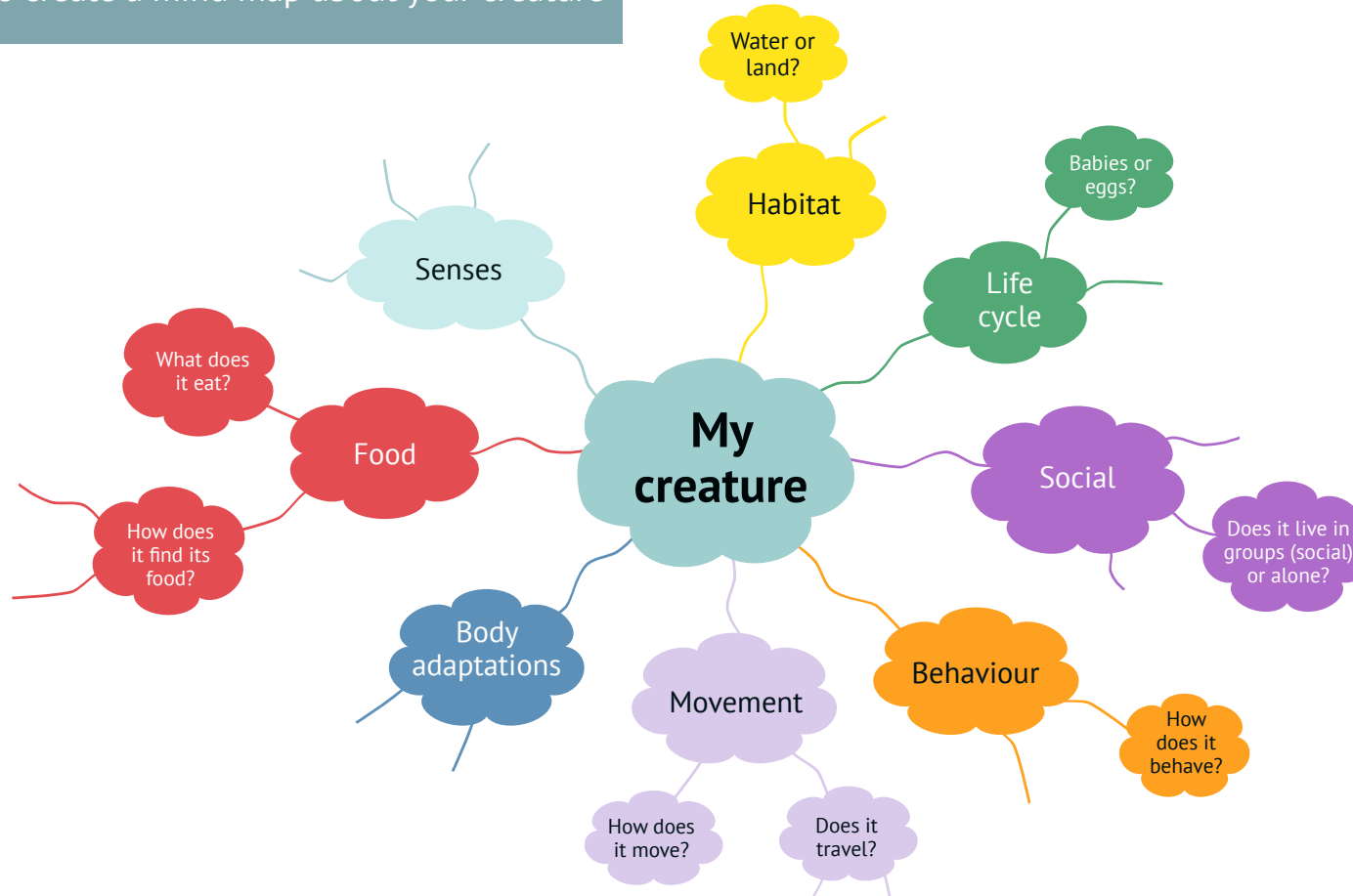


Create your own creature
