## Jesus

### Notes for parents and other adult readers

Sitting down to read a book with a young child is a special privilege, and helping them take early steps in getting to know their world, themselves and God is even more special. However this book is not just intended to be read, but to be a springboard for helping children learn throughout the day (Deuteronomy 6:4-7; Psalm 145:3-7). Here are a few tips to help you adapt your reading and help their learning go beyond these pages:

For really little ones: This book has some hard concepts for really little ones which in time they will understand more fully. (See the website for more explanation of how to read this book with little ones.) Use this book to lay foundations that can be built on as they grow (e.g. emphasising Jesus loves us and Jesus is King). We want children to hear about Jesus, that he is so great that he is the King of everyone, but also so loving that he came to help us. They can join with you in saying "Jesus is the King of everyone, Jesus is the King of everything". Make sure they realise none of the photos in the book are of Jesus.

For bigger ones: There's lots for a child to learn in this little book. Use this book to begin conversations with your child (as appropriate) about what it means that Jesus is King; what it means that Jesus died so we can be God's friends; and how Jesus came to help us, or serve us, even though he is the King of kings. You can talk to your child about how we are to live if Jesus is the King. You can read Mark 4:35-41 for the story of Jesus calming the storm. There are many accounts of Jesus healing people, including Mark 1:29-31, 3:9-10, 5:25-34; Luke 7:1-10.

Other Bible passages to look at: Matthew 20:28; Philippians 2:6-11; Revelation 1:5.

**Pray:** Regularly say short and simple prayers like "Thank you God that Jesus is King", "Thank you that Jesus loves me", and "Thank you that Jesus came so we could be your friends." For more thoughts and tips, see www.teachinglittleones.com/bflo.
