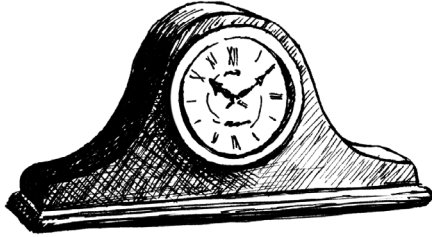

Treasure Quest is an adventure book for teens and pre-teens that contains important truths about God and the new-birth experience. You will follow siblings Brianna and Seth as they travel back in time to witness events from the Bible that reveal God's plan of salvation.

This study guide is designed to help you take your own journey of discovery. Answer the questions thoughtfully, and discuss them with your parents or in a small group. If you get stumped, ask a teacher, youth leader, or pastor for help. They are your guides to help you discover the ancient truths of God for your life today.

What happened to their parents' hotel room?

Read chapters 3 and 4.

Describe in as much detail as you can, the man in the hotel elevator who follows Brianna and Seth:

What did the museum director accuse the children's parents of being?

What do you think the book in the tunnels is?

Who do you think the cab driver is?

Read chapters 5 and 6.

• CHAPTERS 5 AND 6 •

Where (or when) are the children's parents, according to the Time Chronicler?

What will happen to Brianna and Seth if their parents die?

How long do the children have to find their parents and return with them to the present time?

Brianna and Seth arrived in the first century on a very important and special day. What was it? Describe what was happening.

Read chapters 7 and 8.

Who rescued Brianna and Seth at the entrance to the tunnel?

What had this man done to Brianna on the children's last trip to the past?
