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GETTING STARTED

Send home the memory posters for families to review frequently.

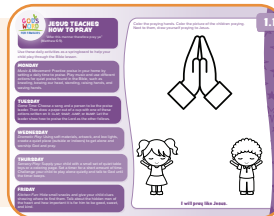


STEP ONE

Each week use the activity page for fun in class before sending it home with the student.

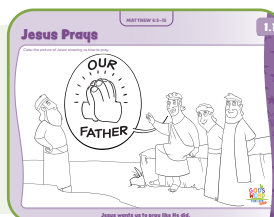


STEP TWO

Each week send home the devotional and activity page for families to use.

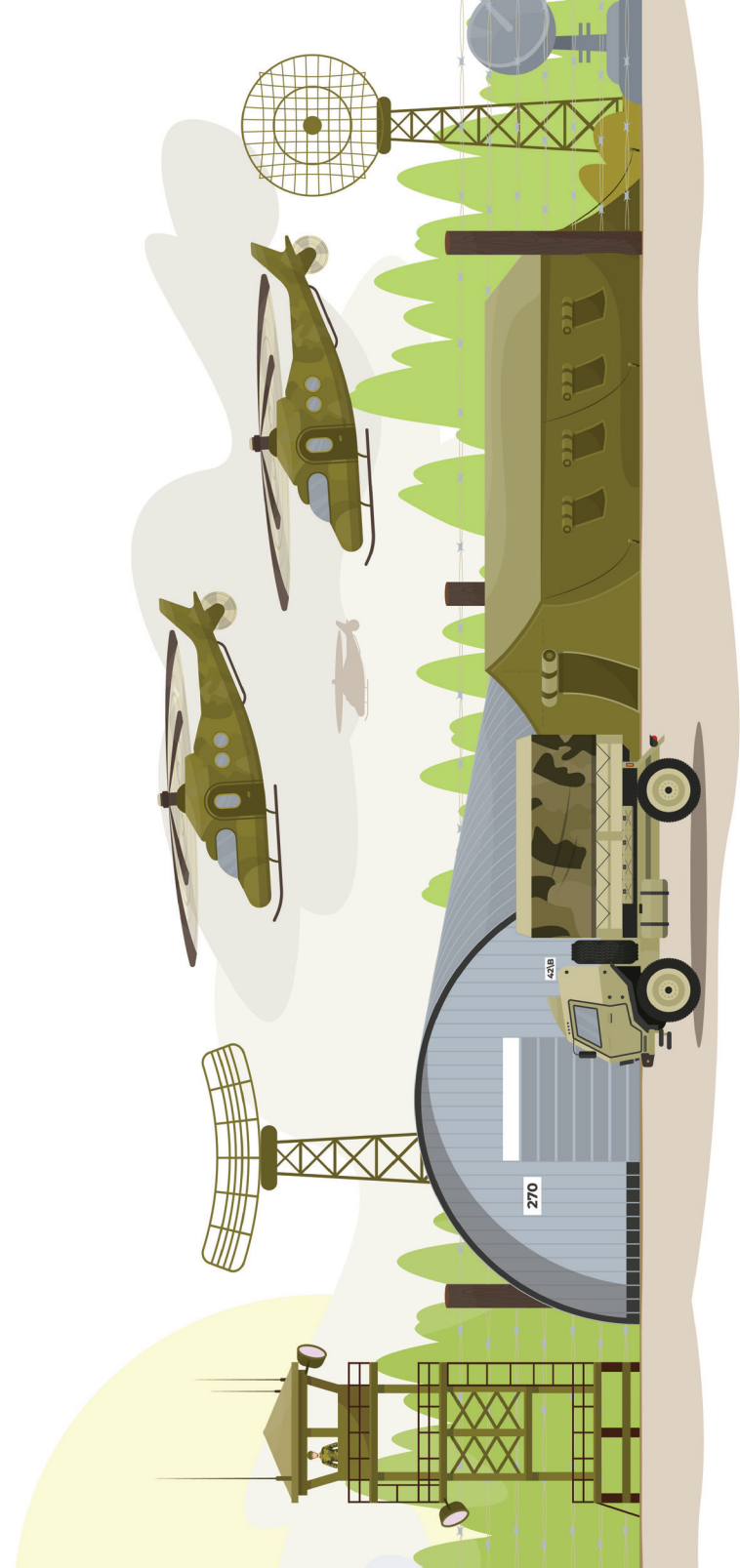


STEP THREE

THE LORD'S PRAYER

"When thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and . . . pray to thy Father which is in secret" (Matthew 6:6).

Use these daily activities as a springboard to help your child play through the Bible lesson.

MONDAY

Music & Movement: Practice praise in your home by setting a daily time to praise. Play music and use different actions for quiet praise found in the Bible, such as kneeling, bowing our head, standing, raising hands, and waving hands.

TUESDAY

Game Time: Choose a song and a person to be the praise leader. Then draw a paper out of a cup with one of these actions written on it: CLAP, SNAP, JUMP, or BUMP. Let the leader show how to praise the Lord as the other follows.

WEDNESDAY

Dramatic Play: Using soft materials, artwork, and low lights, create a quiet place (outside or indoors) to get alone and worship God and pray.

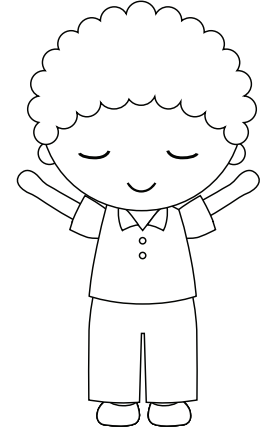
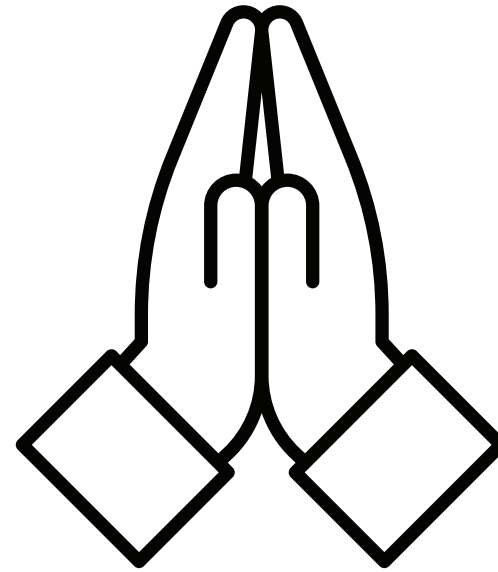
THURSDAY

Sensory Play: Supply your child with a small set of quiet table toys or a coloring page. Set a timer for a short amount of time. Challenge your child to play alone quietly and talk to God until the timer beeps.

FRIDAY

Kitchen Fun: Hide small snacks and give your child clues showing where to find them. Talk about the hidden man of the heart and how important it is for him to be good, sweet, and kind.
