



The zome cover has a lot of fabric that likes to slide off while you are installing it. To help offer an “extra hand”, use the velcro tabs.

1. Loosely secure a velcro tab to the upper ring of metal, just next to the center piece of webbing (center above the door).
2. Unfold/unroll the cover around the zome to the other side of the door center - secure the second piece of velcro.
3. Adjust the cover loosely, and zip up. Ensure the zipper start is fully inserted before zippering.
4. With cover fully on and in place, install door - adjust as needed. (fitted cover only)
5. Install the top piece in the slot in the top assembly.
6. Tightly secure all velcro and drawstrings.



The top piece should not rest above the zome. Water will wick down the rigging and work it's way inside.



At the top assembly, there is a small slot just below the top washer. Ensure that the cover fabric slides into this groove without folds or wrinkles. This will greatly reduce or eliminate any water getting inside.

Fabric Care and Maintenance:

All Kodama covers are made with fabrics that provide long lasting protection against mold and mildew, excellent water and oil repellency, and protects you from both sun and water for many years.

However, the accumulation of dust, pollution particles, foreign organic materials, and general dirt can damage this protection, shortening the life of the fabric, so they should be removed.

The most effective method for maintaining your cover is to clean the canvas once a month with water using a low pressure hose, thereby reducing dirt accumulation.

If you are cleaning the fabric before removing and folding away, it is very important that the canvas be allowed to completely dry before storage.

Normal cleaning:

1. Brush off dust and dirt with a soft brush. NEVER brush with stiff brushes since this can damage the fabric finish.
2. Spray the awning with clean water. If a hose is used, to avoid high pressure.
3. Prepare a solution of solvent-free soap in warm water (no more than 40°C) and apply it on the fabric.
4. Scrub with a soft brush allowing the solution penetrate the fabric.
5. Rinse with water to remove all traces of soap.
6. Let air dry or use soft towel with light touch.

Our fabrics are highly resistant to the growth of fungus, mold, and mildew, however - it can grow on embedded dirt. To clean these stains, follow these more intensive cleaning procedures:

Intensive cleaning:

1. Brush off dust and dirt with a soft brush. NEVER brush with stiff brushes since it could damage the finish and fabric.
2. Prepare a solution with 5% household bleach, 20% of solvent-free neutral detergent and 75% water.
3. Apply the solution on the fabric, allowing to remain between 15 and 20 minutes maximum.
4. Rinse with clean water several times. Bleach residues remaining on canvas combined with the sun could damage the fabric.
5. Allow to air dry completely.
6. Repeat the process if necessary.
7. If you notice your cover losing water repellency over time, you can apply standard, non-solvent based spray repellents on the seams and fabric. Follow product instructions and test on inconspicuous area first.
