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SMALL ZOME LOUNGER - TIPS FOR ASSEMBLY VIDEO DIFFERENCES

Congratulations on your purchase of a zome!

Our video editors are working away at the new videos, so in the meantime, we are using the Large Lounger Videos as an aide for the Small Lounger assembly.

But no worries, the Small model is very similar to our Larger model, with just a few small differences. The videos for both the Zome Structure and the Stand are very helpful and will only take 5 minutes for the stand and 20 minutes for the zome...saving you and/or your installer much time in the long run.

Zome Assembly Video

Noted Differences:

- The attachment point should be about 72" above the ground/floor.
- When lifting the Small Lounger out of the box, lift slowly by the BIG EYE BOLT. The door portion of the zome is tucked under the mattress, so be sure to lift the edges of the mattress to free the door portion from the mattress (making the Lounger easier to lift).
- The entire first horizontal ring of the Small Lounger has already been assembled, so there is no "Level 1" as the assembly video states.
- The upper door diagonals are also already installed. You will need to loosen or tighten the webbing along these diagonals as needed to place the remaining horizontal pieces and bottom shackles.
- The simple zome cushion is MUCH easier to install...just place it on the base and you're done!
- REMINDER – Once the zome is completely assembled, be sure to go around to adjust slack or tension portions of the webbing as well as check to see that rings/levels are horizontal. As you use the zome, the webbing will settle into shape and even out as well.

Stand Assembly Video (If Applicable)

Noted Differences:

- There is no "front" bottom piece. All of the bottom sections and bottom "knuckles" are the same.
 - To create the base: connect all (3) bottom sections to (2) of the bottom knuckles, hand-tightening the bolts. This will get you to the same stage as the hand-tighten portion of the Large Lounger Stand video.
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- With a helper, install (2) of the legs and the top piece - same as the video - with oil on the insert pieces.
- Install the (1) remaining leg onto the top piece first and then onto the remaining knuckle (similar to the last bottom piece of the Large Lounger Stand).
- Secure the final knuckle to the base with the remaining bolts
- Tighten and secure all bolts with wrench/socket.
