

- 1, Screw the threaded fixing bolt into the bottom of the mixer body
- 2, Screw both Flexi Tails into the tap body, ensuring that the O-Ring on the tail is positioned inside the tap body. Hand tighten, do not use PTFE tape or similar to create the seal.
- 3, Offer the tap up to the hole in the sink
- 4, On the underside of the sink fit the rubber and metal horseshoe shaped washers onto the threaded fixing bolt and using the nut provided tighten until the tap is secure in the mounting hole.




