

Design Inspired by Vincent van Gogh

The Dutch post-impressionist painter, the world greatest artist, Vincent van Gogh created over 2,100 artworks and nearly 900 oil paintings in his short life.



The Starry Night is one of the best-known Vincent van Gogh paintings of all time. It depicts the view from the east-facing window of his asylum room at Saint-Rémy-de-Provence, just before sunrise, with the addition of an idealized village. The painting was created in 1890. Since 1941 it sits proudly in the Museum of Modern Art in New York City in USA.

Van Gogh started painting Irises at in May 1889 at the asylum. The painting was probably influenced by Japanese ukiyo-e woodblock prints like many of his works and those by other artists of the time. The painting is full of softness and lightness. Irises is full of life without tragedy. This painting is collected at the J. Paul Getty Museum in Los Angeles, USA



This is one of our favourite tapestry patterns, based on one of the best-known and best-loved of all Vincent van Gogh paintings. Painted on January of 1889, the Original Sunflowers in blue green background Oil on canvas, is collected at Neue Pinakothek, Munich, Germany



Design Inspired by Leonardo da Vinci

Leonardo da Vinci, (1452-1519), Italian painter, draftsman, sculptor, architect, and engineer who is regarded as a genius, perhaps more than that of any other figure. His Last Supper and Mona Lisa are among the most popular and influential paintings of the Renaissance. His notebooks reveal a spirit of scientific inquiry and a mechanical inventiveness that were centuries ahead of their time.

Mona Lisa



Probably the best-known and most studied painting of all time, *Mona Lisa* by da Vinci depicts Lisa Gherardini, wife of a merchant. It continues to captivate millions of visitors who flock to see it every year in the Louvre Museum in Paris, where it's been on display since 1797.

Lady with an Ermine



Lady with an Ermine was probably painted by da Vinci around 1490, pre-dating his *Mona Lisa* by around ten years. At the time, da Vinci was in the employ of Duke Ludovick Sforza, and the subject of the portrait is thought to be the Duke's mistress.

Design Inspired by Great Masterpieces

Monet-Poppy Field



The French impressionist Claude Monet's 'Poppy Field' is one of the world's most famous paintings, it conjures up the vibrant atmosphere of a stroll through the fields on a summer's day. Monet showed Poppy Field to the public at the first impressionist exhibition in 1874. The painting is located at Musee d'Orsay, Paris.

Vermeer-Girl with a Pearl Earring



In 2006, the Dutch public voted Girl with a Pearl Earring as the most beautiful painting in the Netherlands. Painted during the Dutch Golden Age by Johannes Vermeer (1632 – 1675), the picture depicts a strikingly beautiful girl in a blue and gold headscarf. Set against a black background, her face is illuminated by an unseen light, her large pearl earring is prominently displayed. This oil paint is held in Mauritshuis, The Hague, Netherlands.

Degas-Two Dancers on a Stage



Two ballerinas dancing on stage was printed by French artist Edgar Degas (1834–1917). Degas was fascinated by the world of dance, and over half of Degas paintings are of dancers. In this painting, the graceful movement of the dancer in her ballet clothes, and the light of the theatre are captured perfectly. It is collected at Courtauld Gallery, London, UK.

Hokusai-The Great Wave off Kanagawa



Japanese artist Katsushika Hokusai's image, The Great Wave Off Kanagawa, dramatically captures the power of nature. The original picture was created in 1831 using woodblock print on paper, and has become one of the world's most iconic images. Original impressions of the print are in many Western collections, including the Metropolitan Museum of Art, the British Museum, the Art Institute of Chicago, the Los Angeles County Museum of Art, among many other collections.

Steinlen-Tournée du Chat noir



This delightful art nouveau poster was created by the Swiss-born French Art Nouveau painter and printmaker, Théophile Steinlen (1859 - 1923). The poster features a haughty black cat sitting neatly with its gaze fixed on the viewer. It is collected at Zimmerli Art Museum at Rutgers University, USA.

Walter Crane-Swan



The design is portion of "Swan, Rush and Iris" wallpaper by Walter Crane, who created in 1875. silhouetted swans against a stylised background of rush and iris, suggesting the influence of Greek vase paintings. The original design is collect at V & A, London.

Gustav Klimt's work influenced the art nouveau movement, and his painting The Kiss was the highpoint of his 'Golden Period'. Klimt was inspired by Japanese art and the female form, and his art was the subject of controversy, especially when he completed the ceiling of the Great Hall of the University of Vienna. He remains one of the best-loved artists from the art nouveau period.

Klimt-Tree of Life























































This pattern was originally a study for a series of mosaics commissioned for the Palais Stoclet in Brussels. Done in rich, warm colours, this piece presents the traditional Tree of Life bearing fruit and birds, but in a flowing, spiraling nouveau style. Klimt-Kiss



Also known as 'Lovers', The Kiss is perhaps Gustav Klimt's most famous work, painted between 1908 and 09. It is said to be the high point of his Golden phase, The original art is collected in Belvedere Museum, Vienna Austria.
