

# How to make a Woven Cord Taco



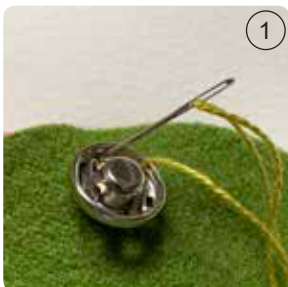
We love the feeling of accomplishment that comes from completing a project. Best of all, we like to complete it within a few hours. Our Circle Loom is all about quick gratification weaving in the round and it makes cute little woven circles. We turned our circles into colorful little cord tacos and this tutorial will show you the materials we used and how we used them. Before you know it, you will have all your phone cords and earbuds all neat and tidy with colorful handmade cord tacos. This tutorial will outline the materials and all the simple steps.



### Materials needed:

- one finished Circle Loom woven circle, approximately 5" diameter
- fabric or felt circle the same size or slightly smaller than the woven circle
- fabric adhesive
- sew on snaps
- scissors, needle & thread

**Materials Notes:** We used Sue Spargo *Eleganza Perle* #3 in a variety of colors to weave our circle and Sue Spargo felted wool for the felt circle. The Sew-On Snaps are by *Dritz* and fabric adhesive is by *Liquid Stitch*.

Sew the snaps in alignment to the fabric or felt. We do this first so the back stitching will not be visible.

Attach the woven circle and fabric/felt circle together with fabric adhesive.

Allow it to dry for about 30 minutes.
