

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS




WARNING

TO GUARD AGAINST INJURY, BASIC PRECAUTIONS SHOULD BE OBSERVED, INCLUDING THE FOLLOWING:

A) READ AND FOLLOW ALL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS.


- B) DANGER To avoid possible electric shock, special care should be taken since water is employed in the use of aquarium equipment. For each of the following situations, do not attempt repairs by yourself; return the appliance to an authorized service facility for service or discard the appliance:
 - If the appliance falls into the water, DON'T reach for it! First unplug it and then retrieve it.
 If electrical components of the appliance get wet, unplug the appliance immediately. (Non-immersible equipment only)
 - If the appliance shows any sign of abnormal water leakage, immediately unplug it from the power source. (Immersible equipment only)
 - Carefully examine the appliance after installation. It should not be plugged in if there is water on parts not intended to be wet.
 - 4) Do not operate any appliance if it has a damaged cord or plug, or if it is malfunctioning or has been dropped or damaged in any manner.
 - 5) To avoid the possibility of the appliance plug or receptacle getting wet, position aquarium stand and tank to one side of a wall-mounted receptacle to prevent water from dripping onto the receptacle or plug. A "drip loop," shown in the figure below, should be arranged by the user for each cord connecting an aquarium appliance to a receptacle. The "drip loop" is that part of the cord below the level of the receptacle, or the connector if an extension cord is used, to prevent water traveling along the cord and coming in contact with the receptacle. If the plug or receptacle does get wet, DON'T unplug the cord. Disconnect the fuse or circuit breaker that supplies power to the appliance. Then, unplug and examine for presence of water in the receptacle.
- C) Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- To avoid injury, do not contact moving parts or hot parts such as heaters, reflectors, lamp bulbs, and the like.
- E) Always unplug an appliance from an outlet when not in use, before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning. Never yank the cord to pull the plug from outlet. Grasp the plug and pull to disconnect.
- F) Do not use an appliance for other than intended use. The use of attachments not recommended or sold by the appliance manufacturer may cause an unsafe condition.
- G) Do not install or store the appliance where it will be exposed to the weather or to temperatures below freezing.
- H) Make sure an appliance mounted on a tank is securely installed before operating it.
- I) Read and observe all the important notices on the appliance.
- J) If an extension cord is necessary, a cord with a proper rating should be used. A cord rated for less amperes or watts than the appliance rating may overheat. Care should be taken to arrange the cord so that it will not be tripped over or pulled.
- K) For added safety, the appliance must be plugged into a receptacle controlled by a GFCI (ground fault interrupter) circuit breaker. The device must be properly connected to a grounded three-prong receptacle.
- L) This appliance is intended FOR HOUSEHOLD USE ONLY.
- M) This Light Fixture is required to be used over a covered aquarium. A glass top or protective barrier is required to minimize the fixture's exposure to water.

INSTALLATION

Your new Aquatic Life 1W LED Light Fixture is easy to set-up and install. Follow these simple steps:

- 1) If using multiple fixtures, link two fixtures together (page 5).
- 2) Install the included Aquarium Frame Mounts (page 6) or suspend with optional Suspension Hardware (page 6).
- 3) Connect the Fixture or Fixtures Cord/s to the Driver/s (page 6).

LINKING MULTIPLE FIXTURES

Tools required for installation: Phillips #2 Screwdriver



The Aquatic Life 1W LED Fixture is able to attach to another Aquatic Life 1W LED Fixture of the same length. The Aquarium Frame Mounts are designed to support a total of two linked 1W LED Light Fixtures.

Each fixture includes the hardware needed for connecting it to the other fixture. The Link Hardware Brackets are stored inside the fixture and accessed by removing the Acrylic Lens Cover. To access the Link Hardware:


 Remove the two screws from the right End Plate opposite of the power cord. (Phillips Screwdriver required).





TIP: Place a large towel under the fixture while removing the parts to avoid scratching the fixture.


2) After the two screws are removed, pull the End Plate from the fixture.



 Remove the four screws from the Blue Accent Plate and pull the Blue Accent Plate from the fixture.



4) Slide the Acrylic Lens Cover out of the fixture.



5) Remove the Link Hardware Brackets that are stored on the side of the fixture opposite the power cord.



 Slide the Acrylic Lens Cover back into the fixture and reattach the Blue Accent Plate and End Plate (Make sure to only secure the two middle screws).



LINKING MULTIPLE FIXTURES (CONTINUED)

Tools required for installation: Phillips #2 Screwdriver






NOTE: Prior to connecting multiple light fixtures, remove the Aquarium Frame Mounts.



NOTE: When linking the other end of the fixtures, you will not need to remove the end plates.






- 7) Repeat steps on second light fixture.
- 8) With the two fixtures placed side by side, attach the two Link Hardware Brackets using four screws.
- 9) Secure the outer sides of the Blue Accent Plate with the four remaining screws.
- 10) Repeat steps on the other end of the light fixtures.

AQUARIUM FRAME MOUNTS

 Slide the metal anchors into the channel located on the side of the light fixture. Place two anchors per channel; two for the front and two for the back.




2) Place a Mount over the metal anchor and insert a screw through the Mount and into the anchor. Tighten the screw until the anchor pulls against the inside of the channel and secures the Mount to the fixture. Repeat for each Mount.





NOTE: There are two styles of legs included with the fixture. Position the Mounts so that the legs extend beyond the fixture.







NOTE: The same hardware is used to suspend one or two fixtures.

SUSPENSION SYSTEM (Optional Accessory, Item # 420147)


The Aquatic Life 1W LED Fixture can be hung from overhead supports with the optional suspension hardware. The fixture is equipped with Mounting Points on the housing for easy connection.



WARNING

Suspension hardware should be mounted into a secure surface only. Do not mount hardware directly into drywall/gypsum board or any similar material. Mounting hardware MUST be attached with the J hooks and into wood supports that can handle 75 lbs or more.


PARTS LIST



TIP: Aquatic Life recommends the use of a stud finder to locate an appropriate wood support.



Locate a wood support structure above the aquarium, determine the location for the attachment of the J Hook and secure the J Hook into the wood.



CEILING MOUNT


Position the Ceiling Mount over the J Hook and center the J Hook in the center of the Ceiling Mount hole. Use the two Ceiling Mount Screws to secure to surface.






FIXTURE ATTACHMENT

 If suspending one fixture, slide two Suspension Clips onto each end of the fixture. If suspending two linked fixtures, slide two Suspension Clips into both tracks on each of the linked fixtures.




NOTE: The Suspension Clip will not slide once the connectors are screwed into the clip





FIXTURE ATTACHMENT (CONTINUED)





WARNING: It is extremely important to make sure the anchor is tight and cannot move, this is the part that keeps the light secure to the ceiling.



NOTE: Slide the Decorative Cover down the wire until it meets the top of the Adjustment Hardware above the fixture.

FIXTURE PLACEMENT AND ADJUSTMENT


To adjust the height of the fixture above the aquarium, first make sure the wire anchor is tight to the wire and that there is a loop that can be placed over the J Hook in the ceiling.

Place the loop of wire onto the J Hook and allow the wire to suspend from the hook.

Pull any excess wire through the Adjustment Hardware located above the fixture. Level the fixture and measure the amount of extra wire pulled through the Adjustment Hardware. You will need the measurement for the next step in installation.

Remove the suspension wires from the J Hooks. Loosen the two screws located in the Wire Anchor so that the wire can slide freely in the anchor. The amount of extra wire pulled through the Adjustment Hardware should now be pulled through the wire anchor.

After the extra wire is pulled through the Wire Anchor, secure the two screws in the anchor. Place the loop in the suspension wire back over the J Hooks in the ceiling.



DECORATIVE COVER

Pull the Decorative Cover up and over the Ceiling Mount and attach the two Decorative Cover Screws into the side opening. Secure the Cover.




1W LED LIGHT FIXTURES MAINTENANCE

POWER

The Aquatic Life 1W LED Light Fixture is powered by a remote Driver.

- 1) Plug the cord connected to the light fixture into the cord exiting the Driver Box.
- Connect the power cord into a grounded outlet (GFCI). Rock the switch on the Driver Box to turn on the light fixture. (Multiple power cords are required when connecting multiple fixtures together.)



MAINTENANCE



WARNING: The fixture is not waterproof. Do not spray or submerge the fixture.

HOUSING

Unplug the 1W LED Light Fixture and wipe the housing with a clean moist/semi dry cloth to remove dust, salt and other debris that may have built-up on the fixture.



TIP: Keep the Acrylic Lens Cover and Glass Cover over the aquarium clean to allow maximum light penetration into the aquarium.

LENS COVER

Wipe the Acrylic Lens Cover with fresh water or an acrylic cleaner to maintain peak light transmission. If the Lens Cover is allowed to become dirty, it will reduce the amount of light that is emitted into the aquarium.
