


# ERGONOMIC CHAIR Assembly & User Guide

# Chair Components




# Step 1

With the five-star base upside-down, push the five castors into each hole. Once completed, turn over so the wheels are on the floor and insert the cylinder into the five-star base. No tools necessary.

Set the assembled base aside for now—we'll get back to it later.

BRANCH TIP: Place the larger end of the cylinder through the top of the five-star base center hole



## Step 2


Thread each screw with a spring washer and then a flat washer.

With the chair back and mechanism upside down, slide the chair back into the slot of the chair mechanism.

Secure the middle screw loosely first to hold the two pieces together, then secure the left and right screws.

Once assembled, set the chair frame aside for now.


**BRANCH TIP**: Tighten these screws as hard as you can to make sure the back is stable—there should be no rattle or movement.



# Step 3

Place the hex nut inside the hex hole in the armrest so that it lays flat. Repeat for both armrests.

BRANCH TIP: If you're having trouble inserting the hex nut, use a hammer to gently tap it in.



## Step 4


With the chair seat upside down, insert both armrests into the sides of the chair seat, making sure the adjustment buttons face the front of the chair.

(Note: the front of the seat has a square lever on left side when upside down).

Insert screws into the hex nuts and tighten.


BRANCH TIP: The screws will not tighten fully or be flush. That's okay! Make sure the armrests slide back and forth freely once attached. You'll use the armrest levers to lock them in place at the right width.

# Step 5

Grab the chair frame and insert it into the pneumatic cylinder. Push down firmly to secure.




# Step 6

Get the assembled seat and pull out the square lever on the right side of the chair.

Holding the lever open, slide seat onto chair base. Push the seat all the way to the back of the base and release the lever to secure.

**BRANCH TIP**: Use the square lever to adjust the depth of the seat once it's attached.



## Step 7

**BRANCH TIP**: Enjoy! Take a seat and go for a test drive.

- Height: twist the right lever to move height up and down
- Tilt: twist the left lever and lean to recline, twist again to lock
- Armrest Width: lock your side levers at desired width to ensure stability
- Armrest Height /
   Depth: push buttons on
   armrests to adjust
   height, slide for depth
- Lumbar: push at base to move up or down
- Seat Depth: pull the square lever to move seat in and out





# FAQ & Troubleshooting

ISSUE	PHASE	SUGGESTION
The hex nut won't fit into the insert on the armrests.	Assembly	Use a mallet or hammer to gently tap the hex nuts into the insert.
The armrest bolts don't seem fully tightened.	Assembly	The bolts attaching the armrests to the chair should permit them to slide. Use the the locking levers to tighten (see below).
I can't get the seat onto the chair frame.	Assembly	Pull out the square lever on the side of the seat before attempting to slide onto the frame.
My chair won't tilt.	Usage	Make sure to unlock the tilt by twisting the left lever on your chair up.
My chair is stuck in the reclined position.	Usage	If your chair is stuck mid-tilt, recline all the way back until you hear a click. That will reset the tilt lock and your chair back should rise to neutral.
The armrests on my chair are wobbling or not stable.	Usage	After you set your preferred armrest width, make sure to lock the armrests using the two levers above the height and tilt adjustment levers. When locked, these

feels uncomfortable.

Usage
levers should be parallel to the seat.

Use the two handles on either side of the lumbar support to adjust it up or down.
