



Basic installation instructions for JUKI MCS BINDER KIT

Pre-Installation check of kit contents

You should have: 1 x Binding folder attachment

1 x Binder mount bracket

2 x M3 Countersunk phillips Mount bracket screws 2 x M4 Cheesehead slotted binder mount screws

2 x Silver flat washers

Tools required: 1 x #1 Size phillips type screw driver


1 x Flat type screw driver

What is in the bag/kit



Step 1.

Using phillips screwdriver and 2 x M3 Countersunk screws, attach the bracket to machine cover plate attachment holes.



Step 2.

Unfold the binding tension guide.



Step 3.

Using flat screwdriver, attach the binder to mounting bracket with 2 x washers and 2 x M4 screws.

Step 4.

Align binder in approximate position to needles before tightening.



Cut binding tape to a angle / point and feed tape into the binder.

NOTE:

Step 5.

For reliable results, the binding tape MUST be cut accurately to correct size. If using a stretch binding tape that may shrink under some tension, better results could be achieved if binding cut1-2mm wider than binder folder specification.





Step 6.

Drag binding tape through and turn back and load under presser foot



Step 7.

In normal circumstances, we would remove the right hand needle and run binding at two needles only (left and centre)



Run machine to stitch some binding and inspect results.

Step 8.

Additional binder alignment can be completed with by loosening the slotted M4 screws or fine tuning of top/bottom folded edges can be made by adjusting the binder fingers.



Step 9.

Continue alignments and practice binding onto material by placing the panel into the throat of binder device. The binding will assist panel feed through machine.



Once your binding task is complete, remove the binder attachment from bracket using the M4 slotted screws with flat screw driver.

Step 10.

We recommend leaving the binder mounting bracket installed on your machine for future use. We expect this bracket being in place does not interfere with normal overstitch seaming work.
