

Ladder End Bunk Bed Assembly Instructions



Please read all instructions before beginning

- 1. Assemble lower bed using 2 bed rails (C), 2 lower bed ends (A), and 8 connector bolts (F), with 8 cross dowels (G). Refer to Figure 1 for correct position of bed rail, bed end and hardware.
 - a. **Optional Loft version**: Front bed rail and 9 slats are omitted from the lower bed assembly
- 2. Assemble top bed using 2 bed rails (C), 2 top bed ends (B), and 8 connector bolts (F), with 8 cross dowels (G). Refer to Figure 2 for correct position of bed rail, bed end and hardware.
- 3. Insert 4 bunkbed pins (I) into the predrilled holes of the lower bed ends. Place the top bed assembly onto the lower bed assembly ensuring that the bunkbed pins are captured in the predrilled holes in the top bed ends.
- Slats (E) slide into groove of bed rails and must be secured using screws (H) through pre-drilled holes, refer to Figure

 Begin by positioning a slat in the centre and screwing one end inside the groove. From the opposite side of the secured slat pull slat towards you while pushing second bed rail to secure second end of centre slat while fully inside groove. Once the centre slat is secured at both ends position the remaining eight slats equally with no spaces greater than 3-1/2" and screw into place.
- 5. Slide guard rails (D) into the top bunkbed ends, refer to Figure 4.



Important Safety Tips:

- 1. Children under 6 years of age should not use the top bed.
- 2. Teach children that rough play on bunk beds is dangerous.
- 3. Use provided ladders or stairs to climb in and out of top bed.
- 4. Do not tie anything to the bunkbed, such as cords and ropes.
- 5. Keep guardrails in place.
- 6. Check that all hardware is properly secured twice a year.
