



Top Cap Replacement

Tools Required: Screw, Screwdriver, Hammer

Wood Plug Removal

- 1. Insert a small (#6 approximately) wood screw into the <u>centre</u> of the wood plug. The screw will contact the head of the screw under the wood plug.
- 2. Continuing to drive the screw in will cause the wood plug to pull out.
- 3. Remove the plug from the screw to re-use the screw. Discard the damaged plug.





Removing and Replacing the Top Cap

- 4. After removing the wood plugs, remove the wood screws. Keep for re-use.
- 5. Place end screws in the new Top Cap and position them in the existing screw holes.
- 6. Tighten the 2 end screws, position the remaining screws and tighten.
- 7. Position the replacement wood plugs in the holes.
- 8. Using a piece of cardboard or wood to protect the surface of the top cap, gently tap the wood plugs flush with the surface of the top cap.
