1.0 Earthaus Primer Grit

1.1 Description

Earthaus Primer Grit is a fine-grained pumice aggregate formulated as an additive to mix into interior water-based latex primer, then applied over level-4 finished drywall or a previously painted wall before plaster application.

1.2 Product Use

A. Interior Earthaus Plaster Finishes recommending priming with added Primer Grit:

- 1. Tadelakt Finish: Non-Shower
- 2. Marble Finish
- 3. Stone Finish
- 4. Sand Finish

B. Earthaus Plaster Finishes that should not use Primer Grit

- 2. Tadelakt Finish: Shower
- 3. Lime Slurry Finish
- 4. Lime Stucco: Fine or Coarse Finishes

1.3 Packaging & Coverage

One 3 lb package of Earthaus Primer Grit contains five cups of Grit. One cup of Primer Grit is mixed into a gallon of primer. The full package, five cups, is mixed into 5 gallons of primer.

- Free flowing granular powder
- Increases adhesion of plaster
