## Job Details

As Production Manager, you will ensure that manufacturing equipment and tools function properly and efficiently, you will support warehouse operations to ensure that all incoming and outgoing inventory is processed according to schedule, and you will support retail operations to hold events and attract and retain customers to meet their shopping, including (but not limited to) the duties below:

#### **General Duties:**

#### Production

- Building and executing production schedules
- Training, supporting, and providing guidance to production staff
- Ensuring adequate scheduling of production staff
- Setting productivity goals for each production team/shift
- Ensuring all safety and health standards are met to keep our organization incident-free
- Evaluating equipment and resources to ensure continued production and minimal downtime
- Ensure production processes stay within budgets and deadlines
- Communicating with upper management regarding problems or issues impacting production

#### Warehouse

- Ensure products are shipped in a timely manner
- Assist upper management with inventory and recommend which items to restock
- Assist upper management in establishing efficient warehouse practices and protocols

## Retail/Events

- Training new employees and providing ongoing education for employees working events
- Assist upper management with retail presence, including inventory for events and loss prevention
- Assist upper management with creating advertising campaigns and/or retail promotions to attract new customers and retain current customers

## **Work Environment:**

- The production areas have moderate to loud noise levels.
- Production areas are temperature controlled, which may include cold or hot environments.
- You may be required to work overtime, which may include Saturdays, or the possibility of working in another department as needed.
- Must maintain a reasonable production speed once the training period has ended.

- Completes work with minimum supervision
- Ability to continuously build knowledge and skills

# **Physical Requirements:**

- Perform other duties as assigned
