



Notebook Cover Tutorial


Materials Required:


- (2) piece of vinyl 7" x 11" (Vinyl A & Vinyl B) (6" x 8" for mini)
- (2) pieces of vinyl 4" x 6.5" (Vinyl A) (3" x 6" for mini)
- (1) 2" x 2" piece of coordinating vinyl (Vinyl B)
- 12" of 1/2" elastic (10.5" for mini) please check your fit, you may prefer a longer or shorter length depending on your elastic
- Medium weight tear away stabilizer (or cut away depending on design)











Stabilizer Front Stabilizer Back Vinyl A Vinyl B Elastic


1) Hoop stabilizer and run first step of the design directly on the stabilizer.




2) Place one of the larger pieces of vinyl (Vinyl A) over the outline stitch from step 1, RIGHT SIDE UP. Run the design portion of the cover.




3) After completing the design portion of the cover, stitch the placement box for the elastic.




4) Take one end of the 1/2" elastic and place it inside the box. Use care to make sure that the short edge is inside the box. Run the next step on the machine to tack down this end of the elastic.



5) Bring the other short end of the elastic so it is inside the box from the previous step. Make SURE that the elastic is NOT twisted, and if necessary, tape down the excess elastic so it does not get stitched down. The only part of the elastic that should be stitched is the ends. You may wish to tape the elastic down and the excess elastic out of the way. Run the next step to tack down this end of the elastic.




6) Take the 2" x 2" piece of vinyl and place it right over the box stitched in the previous step. Run the next steps to stitch out the box and secure the elastic. Again, use care to make sure that the excess elastic dosn't get caught up when stitching the vinyl. Using sharp scissors, trim VINYL ONLY around the box, being careful not to cut the elastic.




7) Remove the hoop from your machine but do NOT unhoop the materials. Flip the hoop over and place the second large piece of vinyl (Vinyl B) on the backside of the hoop. The vinyl should be right side up, with the wrong side against the stabilizer. Tape in place and return the hoop to your machine. Run the next step to tack down the vinyl.

8) Once again, remove the hoop from your machine but do NOT unhoop materials. Flip over the hoop and tape down the 2 smaller pieces of vinyl as shown at right. There should be a gap between the two pieces at the center. This will create the pockets that the notebook front and back cover will slide into.



9) Run the final step of the design to stitch the center spline of the notebook cover, this will help the cover lay nicely when folded. If you have used thicker materials, it may not fold crisply right away. Put it over a notebook and leave it closed, and stack something heavy on top overnight.
