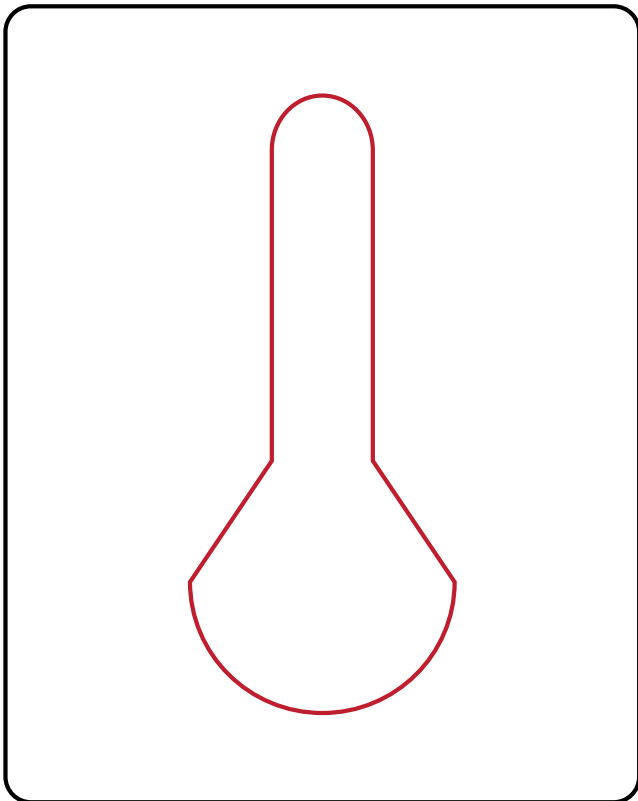




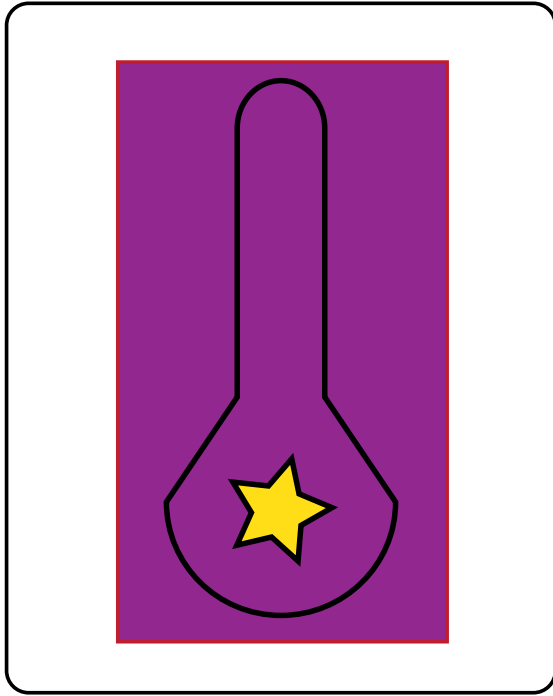
Snap Tab Tutorial

Materials Required:

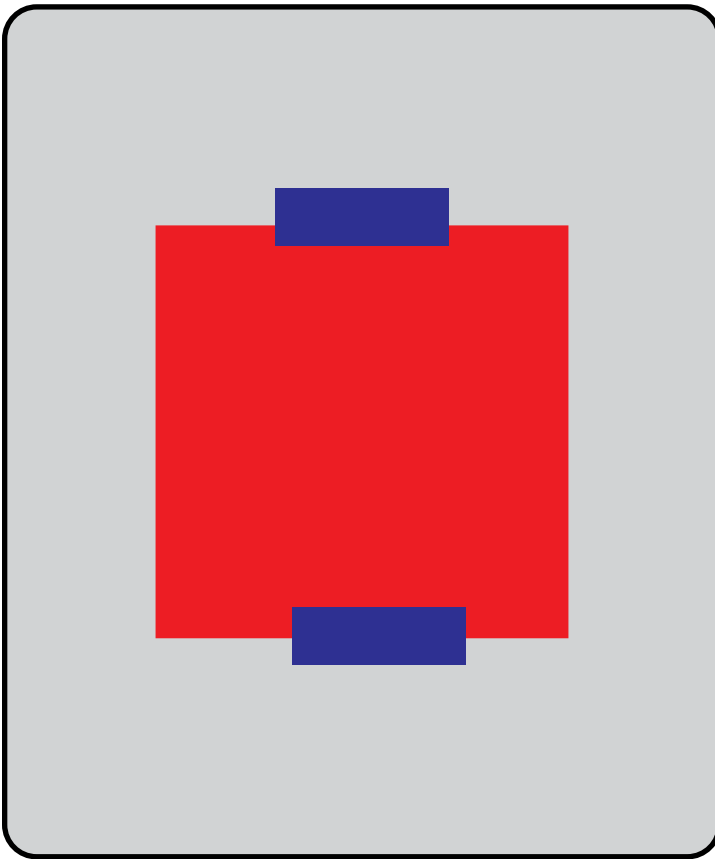
- (2) 5" x 5" Scraps of Vinyl, Cork, Leather, Kraftex, or other non-fraying material
- (1) Set of Kam Snaps or similar
- (1) Key Ring or Swivel Clip
- Medium weight tear away stabilizer
- Water Soluable Stabilizer (for denser or more intricate designs)
- Masking tape



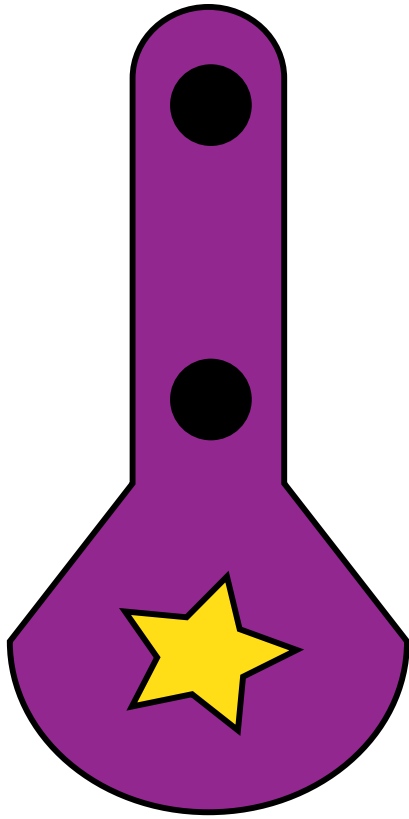
1) Hoop stabilizer in hoop and run the first step to run placement stitching on stabilizer.



2) Place vinyl or other material on top and run the remaining steps of the design, except **STOP** before you get to the last step.



3) Remove the hoop from the machine but DO NOT unhoop the materials. Flip the hoop over so you are now working with the back side of the hoop. Place the backing on the stabilizer, right side up and tape in place. Run the final step of the design to secure the backing.



4) Remove from hoop, remove stabilizer and trim around the design about 1/4" from stitching. Install a set of Kam snaps where pictured per manufacturer's instructions.
