
1. Place the installation board on the ceiling (the ceiling is metal) and keep the four-inch round hole concentric.




3. Install the assembled lamps to the ceiling. Use shrapnel to position the lamp on the ceiling and lock the fixtures.




2. Put the shrapnel on the LED light, then tighten the shrapnel with two screws.



4. Turn installation board clockwise and tighten the four screws to connect the power cord to the junction box.





1. There is a four-inch junction box on the ceiling. And according to the mounting hole of the lamp,insert the rubber-plug into the ceiling (using the rubber-plug according to the actual situation).

2. Lift up the lamp, connect the power cord to the ceiling, and tighten the four self-tapping screws.

(3) same as (1)

1.Assemble conduit and wiring box to luminaire .

2.Seal 1/2" conduit threads preventing water entry into wireway.

3.Seal luminaire and screw penetration through canopy deck preventing water leaking to bottom.

4.Make wiring connections in wiring box
