Installation Instructions

MIN. LAMP COMPARTMENT DIMENSIONS: 5.91 (DIA) x 3.94 (H) inch for 5W. MIN. LAMP COMPARTMENT DIMENSIONS: 7.87 (DIA) x 4.92 (H) inch for 7W. Note: Ballast bypass instructions apply only to GX23 and G24q base lamps.

- 1. Make sure the circuit breaker that supplies power to the fixture is turned off.
- 2. Remove trim and existing lamp(s) from recessed fixture. Drop housing from plaster frame.
- 3. Remove inner junction box cover and disconnect ballast from input wiring and lampholder leads. Dispose of removed ballast and lamps in accordance with government regulations in your area.





Figure 2. Retrofit with Two Lamps (GX23 Base)





Figure 4. Retrofit with Two Lamps (G24q Base)

- 4. Connect input wiring to lampholder leads according to the appropriate diagram below (Figure 1, 2, 3, 4). Place wires and connections back in wiring box and replace cover.
- 5. Reinstall housing and trim.
- 6. Install your new MaxLite LED PL lamps. Rotate lamps to desire position.
- 7. Apply relamping Label on a visible location inside the fixture.
- 8. Turn power on at the breaker box and turn on the lights.

Figure 3. Retrofit with One Lamp (G24q Base)
