## NOTE

To keep shaping sts separate from eyelets, all increases and decreases are worked on the wrong side of the work.

## BACK

Using smaller ndls and MC, CO 150 ( $166,182,196,216$ ) sts. Work in
K1, P1 Rib for $4^{\prime \prime}$, ending with a RS row. Next row, change to larger ndls and CC1 and dec: (P1, p2tog twice) to last $0(1,2,0,1)$ sts, p $0(1,2,0,1) .90(100,110,120,130)$ sts. Work in Eyelet Stitch, beg with Row 2, and dec 1 st each end every $4^{\text {th }}$ row 6 times -78 (88, $98,108,118)$ sts. Work even until piece measures $13^{\prime \prime}$ from beg, ending with a RS row. Inc 1 st each end of next and every foll $4^{\text {th }}$ row a total of 4 times - $86(96,106,116,126)$ sts. When piece measures $15\left(141 / 2,141 / 2,15 \frac{1}{2}, 151 / 2\right)$ ", ending with a RS row, shape armholes: BO 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows, then dec 1 st at each end every $4(4,4,2,2)$ rows a total of $2(2,3,6,9)$ times $-72(82,90,94,98)$ sts. Work even until armhole measures $7\left(71 / 2,7^{1 / 2}, 8^{1 / 2}, 8^{1 / 2}\right)$ ". Shape shoulders: BO $5(7,7,7,8)$ sts at beg of next 4 rows, then $6(6,8,8,8)$ sts at beg of foll 2 rows. BO rem $40(42,46,50,50)$ sts for back neck.

## LEFT FRONT

Using smaller ndls and MC, CO $80(88,96,104,112)$ sts. Work in K1, P1 Rib for $4 "$, with a RS row. Cut MC. Slip last 15 sts to holder. Change to larger ndl, join CC1 and p next row, dec $22(25,27,31,33)$ sts evenly spaced while purling - $44(48,54,58,64)$ sts. Work in

Eyelet Stitch, beg with Row 2, and dec 1 st at end of every $4^{\text {th }}$ row 6 times - $38(42,48,52,58)$ sts. Work even until piece measures 13 " from beg, ending with a RS row. Inc 1 st at end of next and every foll $4^{\text {th }}$ row a total of 4 times $-42(46,52$, 56,62 ) sts. AT THE SAME TIME, when piece measures $14^{1} / 2\left(141 / 2,14^{1} / 2,161 / 2,16^{1 / 2}\right)$ ", shape front neck: dec 1 st at neck edge every 2 rows $13(11,16,21,23)$ times, then every 4 rows $6(8,6,2,1)$ times. AT THE SAME TIME, when piece measures 15 ( $14112,14112,151 / 2,151 / 2$ )", ending with a WS row, shape armhole. Next row (RS) BO 5 sts, work to end. Dec 1 st at end of WS rows every $4(4,4,2,2)$ rows $2(2,3,6,9)$ times. $16(20,22,22,24)$ sts rem after all shaping is complete. Work even until piece measures same as Back to shoulder, ending having just worked a WS row. Shape shoulder: BO 5 $(7,7,7,8)$ from armhole edge twice, then BO rem $6(6,8,8,8)$ sts.

Using safety pins, mark positions for 7 buttons, the first $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from bottom edge and the last $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ below beginning of Front Neck shaping.

## RIGHT FRONT

Work as for Left Front, reversing shaping, and making buttonholes as follows: At beg of RS row opposite pin on Left Front, (k1, p1) 3 times, k2tog, yo, rib to end.

## SLEEVES

Using smaller ndls and MC, CO $68(68,68,74,74)$ sts. Work in K1, P1 rib for $41 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, ending with a RS row. Next row: change to larger ndls and CCl and p, dec 28 sts evenly spaced across
 row - $40(40,40,46,46)$ sts. Beg with Row 2 of Eyelet Stitch, inc 1 st each end every $4^{\text {th }}$ row 4 times, then every $6^{\text {th }}$ row 5 times $-58(58,58,64,64)$ sts. Work even until sleeve measures $113 / 4$ " from CO edge, ending with a RS row. Shape sleeve cap: BO 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows, then dec 1 st each end every $4^{\text {th }}$ row $2(2,2,3,3)$ times, then every other row 10 times, then every $4^{\text {th }}$ row twice. $20(20,20,24,24)$ sts rem. $\operatorname{BO} 5(5,5,6,6)$ sts at beg of next 2 rows, then BO rem $10(10,10,12,12)$ sts.

## FINISHING

Button and buttonhole bands: Return 15 held sts from Left Front to smaller ndls and rejoin MC with WS facing. Continue in K1, P1 rib, inc 1 st at end of first row - 16 sts. Continue in rib until strip reaches along front opening and front neck edge, and halfway across bound-off sts of Back Neck. Bind off. Return 15 held sts from Right Front to smaller ndls and rejoin MC with RS facing. Continue in K1, P1 rib, inc 1 st at end of first row - 16 sts. Work in rib and continue to make buttonholes opposite pins on Left Front, until strip reaches along front opening and front neck edge, and halfway across bound-off sts of Back Neck. Bind off. Sew shoulder and side seams. Set in sleeves; sew sleeve seams. Sew button and buttonhole bands to front edges and along back of neck; join bands at center back neck. Weave in ends. Block lightly. Sew on buttons.
