Rayas

SIZE

Width: Approx. 53½" Length: Approx. 41½"

MATERIALS

Manos del Uruguay WOOL CLASICA (100% wool; approx.100g/138 yds), 3 sk Color A, 3 sk Color B, 2 sk Color C, 2 sk Color D, 1 sk Color E, 3 sk Color F. Shown in #82 Shocking (A), #59 Kohl (B), #31 Nickel (C), #39 Cirrus (D), #22 Mist (E), #14 Natural (F).

US 9/5.5mm 40" circular needle, or size to obtain gauge

GAUGE

15 stitches and 24 rows = 4" over Stockinette Stitch 12 stitches and 26 rows = 4" over Garter Stitch

STITCH GUIDE

Stockinette Stitch (over any number of stitches) Knit on RS, purl on WS.

Garter Stitch (over any number of stitches) Knit all stitches, every row.

ABBREVIATIONS

RS: right side

sl: slip

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back

NOTES

Circular needle is used to accommodate large number of stitches. Do not join; work back and forth in rows.

INSTRUCTIONS

Stripe 1

With Color A, cast on 58 stitches. Work in Stockinette stitch until piece measures 34" from cast-on. Bind off all stitches. Set piece aside.

Stripe 2

With Color B, cast on 48 stitches. Work in Stockinette stitch until piece measures 34" from cast-on. Bind off all stitches. Set piece aside.

Stripe 3

With Color C, cast on 36 stitches. Work in Stockinette stitch until piece measures 34" from cast-on. Bind off all stitches. Set piece aside.

Stripe 4


With Color D, cast on 26 stitches. Work in Stockinette stitch until piece measures 34" from cast-on. Bind off all stitches. Set piece aside.

Stripe 5

With Color E, cast on 14 stitches. Work in Stockinette stitch until piece measures 34" from cast-on. Bind off all stitches. Set piece aside.



Seam stripes I-5 together using mattress stitch according to the following diagram:



Border, short sides

With RS facing and Color F, pick up and knit 99 stitches evenly along one selvedge edge of blanket. Knit 23 rows, ending after a WS row. Bind off all stitches knitwise. Work other border in the same manner on opposite selvedge edge.

Border, long sides

With RS facing and Color F, pick up and knit 12 stitches evenly along edge of side trim, 142 stitches evenly along blanket edge, then 12 stitches evenly along edge of side trim. [166 stitches]

Next Row: SI I purlwise wyib, knit to end.

Rep the last row 22 more times, ending after a WS row. Bind off all stitches knitwise.

Work other border in the same manner along opposite long edge.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block piece to measurements.
