MATERIALS

Manos del Uruguay SILK BLEND (70% extrafine merino wool, 30% silk; approx. 50g/150 yds), 1(2) sk MC and 1 sk CC.

Shown in 3202 Zinnia (MC) and 300G Coffee (CC).

US H/5mm crochet hook, or size to obtain gauge removable stitch marker

GAUGE 19 sts and 20 rnds = 4" in Stripe Pattern. ABBREVIATIONS BOR: beginning of round CC: contrast color MC: main color pm: place marker rnd(s): round(s) sp(s): space(s) st(s): stitch(es)

CROCHET STITCHES

ch: (crochet chain) *wrap yarn around crochet hook and draw it through the loop on the hook to form the first chain; repeat from * as many times as instructed. (The loop on the hook is never included when counting the number of chains)

sc: (single crochet) insert crochet hook in indicated stitch, yo and pull up a loop; yo and draw through both loops on hook

sl st: (slip stitch) insert crochet hook in indicated stitch; yo and draw through st and loop on hook



STITCH GUIDE

Stripe Pattern (multiple of 2 sts)

Rnd 1: With CC, *ch1, sc into next ch-1 sp; repeat from * to end.

Rnd 2: With MC, repeat Rnd 1.

Rnd 3:Twist MC once around the unused CC strand to carry it along the inside of the cowl. With MC, repeat Rnd I.

Repeat Rnds 1–3 for pattern.

INSTRUCTIONS

COWL

Foundation Chain: With MC, ch 124 (248), sl st into first ch to join, being careful not to twist sts. Pm into last st made for BOR.

Twist Rnd: Ch1, *skip 1 ch, sc into next ch, ch1; repeat from * to marker; rotate the left-hand side of the work 180° toward you, sc into the first ch-1 sp (you'll be working into it from the foundation-chain side, not the side that already has a rnd worked); **ch1, sc into next ch-1 sp; repeat from ** to marker. [125 (249) ch-1 sps]

Note: The strip of fabric now appears 2 rnds wide, with the foundation chain in the center. You're working from the center of the cowl outward, and each rnd adds a row at each side.

Join CC, keeping MC attached.

Work Rnds 1–3 of Stripe Pattern 5 times. SI st into next ch-1 sp to join. Fasten off.

FINISHING Weave in ends. Block to measurements.
